The Indians of Oregon and other northwestern states had heard of the wonderful religion of the white man and wanted to be taught the creed that resulted in so much brotherly feeling. These warlike redskins made their plea through a delegation sent to St. Louis and Marcus Whitman, Mr. and Mrs. Henry Spaulding and other missionaries started in a body from Itzehville, New York, to carry the word of God to the natives who were interested enough to ask for it.
