BRISK-MEET IS DUE SATURDAY

Union to Meet Blues in Dual Track and Field Meet Here; La Grande Favored Slightly.

La Grande and Union, ancient rivals in every field of high school and independent athletics, will meet tomorrow afternoon at the local fairgrounds in a dual track and field meet, the first of the interscholastic schedule for the year.

In the sprints, the 100, 220 and 440 yard dash, the Blues should take many points, with Larson and Captain Price counted upon as winners.
