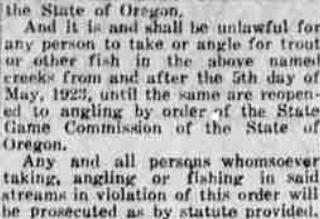
W. FOREST WEEK STARTED (By Charles H. Shinn)
