## Battle Royal To Open Card Here May 3rd

### First Rate Card Arranged; Johnny Fugate and Bus Bairie to Be Headliners.

Ed Ford has announced his complete line-up for the May 3rd boxing card to be held in the Star theater. Here's the way it fits:

**Main Event—10 rounds:** Johnny Fugate of Portland, vs. Bus Bairie, of La Grande.

**Semi-Final—6 rounds:** Jimmy Coker vs. R. Wright, both of La Grande.

**Special 6-round event:** Kid Stup of La Grande, vs. Battling Harris of Pendleton.

**Curtain-Raiser — Battle royal** between 6 juvenile leather-pushers.

All in all the card looks like a whiz-bang affair from start to finish—one that should make the local fans tick their chops in anticipation. Every man on the three main events are fast exponents of skill and nerve and the curtain-raiser can't be anything else but a real drawing card.

A battle royal is, in brief, a competitive contest among three or more participants. The way it will be staged here will be to let six husky youngsters don the gloves, enter the ring together, punch the bell, and keep fighting until the best man wins. In other words, the man left standing is proclaimed victor—and that means the other five have got to be defeated by someone or other. Talk about possibilities—there are more in a battle royal than in 17 bedroom farces.

## Blue Trackmen Preparing for Saturday Meet

Approximately 12 men will be selected to make up the La Grande track and field team that will journey to Pendleton Saturday morning to meet the Bucks' team at the Round-Up park in the afternoon in the last of the dual contests on La Grande's schedule this season. The Blues have won the first two, against Union and Baker, by scores of 102 to 20 and 107 to 15, respectively, but are going into the Pendleton meet with the Bucks as favorites.

La Grande has a chance to win but Pendleton has a better chance in the opinion of the greater portion of the local fans.

Pendleton, throughout the past decade, has had the Indian sign on La Grande. In the track and field sports, at basketball and football alike, the Blues have been stricken by the Bucks' evil when odds were heavily in favor of the La Grander. Of course, Pendleton has not made a clean sweep of La Grande, by any means, but she has taken the majority of the contests.

Last year Pendleton took La Grande to a drubbing on the football field here. When the hoop season rolled around the Bucks walloped the Blues four times out of four, and ended the season by winning the Eastern Oregon track meet.

This fall, with La Grande expected to train the Umatilla county boys on the gridiron, the Bucks upset the local eleven and walked away on the winning end of a 25 to 7 score. La Grande likewise failed to beat them at basketball this winter. And now Pendleton is the favorite in the dual track meet.

This is La Grande's last chance to win an athletic contest from the Pendletonians in a two year period and members of the team, working out like they haven't before this season, are all pepped up to do their best Saturday.

#### Meet Expected Close

The meet is expected to be close. Both teams have a lot of good men on hand but from early season reports, the Bucks have the edge. The writer believes that La Grande has a chance to win if they show their stuff and fail to get "hoodooed" by Pendleton's Indian sign—and the old grads and fans are praying that the Bucks be downed for the first time in two years.

## Third Practice Lures Many

Last evening the Pirate turnout was even larger than on the night before. Hitting and fielding was again in order and many good prospects are showing up in the present stages of practice. Manager Crews and other members of the squad are elated at the showing and are expecting to have a good team whipped into shape by the opening day game's arrival.

Not only will Manager Crews have his present squad to pick from in selecting the opening lineup, but three others will join the team before the Baker game. Tex and Bud Knight, who are now playing in Idaho, will be on hand when the roll is called and McGee, who was on the pitching staff last year, will also answer the summons. Other pitching prospects are coming to light and the way things stand the mound staff is expected to be of a very strong nature.
