preferred stocks, same as a pleasant surprise. The improvement was greater than had been expected. The general opinion is that the improvement will be maintained despite the recent wage increases, as the corporation is gradually working off orders taken at last year's low prices.

Fears of Inflation Expressed. On the other hand, it is maintained in some quarters that the steel corporation's position is not a fair criterion of the general state of business. Some observers claim that recent advances in wages have been attended by a falling off in productivity of labor and that the way is being prepared for an inflation of costs and prices and for a reduction in profits. According to this view conditions in the building industry are distinctly unfavorable, speculation in materials and excessive demands by labor resulting in losses to contractors and the suspension of a projected work. The building industry is taken, however, as an extreme case.

PRETTY TULIPS FROM CAPITAL

The Evening Observer is in receipt of some of the most beautiful tulips possible to grow and they came from the Salem Tulip Farm, an institution that is receiving national prominence because of the quality of tulips produced.

Mrs. J. Donald Meyers, of La Grande, who is spending some time in Salem, upon visiting the beautiful farm remembered a number of her La Grande friends with the flowers. In her letter describing the beauty of the place she says: "Upon visiting the Salem Tulip Farm I could not resist sending a lot of the flowers home. The farm consists of four acres and there are over one million bulbs planted thereon. It is located on a rolling hillside and when one drives toward it the riot of color is simply dazzling. There are 250 varieties now blooming and of course the different varieties differ in size. One especially beautiful variety is a rather small cream colored tulip with an unusual fragrance, which is uncommon in a tulip as you know."

"Mr. Franklin, owner of the farm, states that he is shipping commercially the blooms as far east as Duluth, Minnesota, and the bulbs as far east as New York. Last Sunday it was estimated that between 8,000 and 10,000 people visited the farm, so you can imagine what an unusual attraction it is."

Mrs. Meyers stated in her letter that she is gradually regaining her health which is pleasant news to her many friends in La Grande.

almost a quarter of a million cars ahead of the corresponding weeks in the past two years. These evidences of extraordinary good railroad traffic meanwhile were confirmed by publication of a large number of railroad earnings statements for March which showed an aggregate net yearly totals that for February, and even slightly greater than that for March a year ago, when class one roads as a whole earned 5.33

per cent on valuation. Output at High Rate. Reports from the steel industries show that while the buying movement which started last December is definitely over, output continues at the high rate of the year. I. W. W. Developments. PORTLAND, Apr. 30.—Developments in the Industrial Workers of the World strike situation in Oregon today included reports from the lower Columbia river district that practically every camp there was closed either as the result of the strike or to meet trouble and assertions by the Portland police that no further action by the I. W. W. in closing alleged bootleg establishments would be permitted.

Reports from other parts of the state showed little change from Saturday. Most camps are operating. Two alleged I. W. W. organizers were arrested at Astoria. Portland police announced that they would be glad to get information of liquor violations from the I. W. W. or any organization, but it was illegal for the I. W. W. to take it upon themselves to close suspected places which they did yesterday. I. W. W. leaders said they would continue their activities. In the meantime Portland is busier than ever.
