S. P. Exonerated of All Liability for Deaths In The Probert Tragedy

An echo of a grade crossing accident, which made the whole country shudder, was heard at Red Bluff the other day when a jury composed of eight men and four women exonerated the Southern Pacific company of liability for the death of one of the fourteen young people who were killed.

The accident occurred at Probert, Calif., Nov. 30, 1921, when an automobile in which fifteen youngsters were on their way to high school was struck by a Southern Pacific train in front of which the 17-year-old driver had tried to cross the

track. Fourteen were killed and one badly injured.

Coroner's jury and the Southern Pacific board of inquiry exonerated train crew and company of any blame for the accident. Suits asking for \$30,000, in each case were brought against the Southern Pacific company by the relatives of 13 of the victims. The suit of Red Bluff was the first of the 13 to be decided.

Following the accident the California state railroad commission issued an order requiring that all motor vehicles carrying passengers for hire and all motor trucks, come to a full stop at all grade crossings and make sure of a clear passage before proceeding. Railroad commissioners of other states followed this example. School boards throughout California took cognizance of the accident by imposing strict rules to govern the driving of school busses with particular reference to the crossing of railroad tracks.

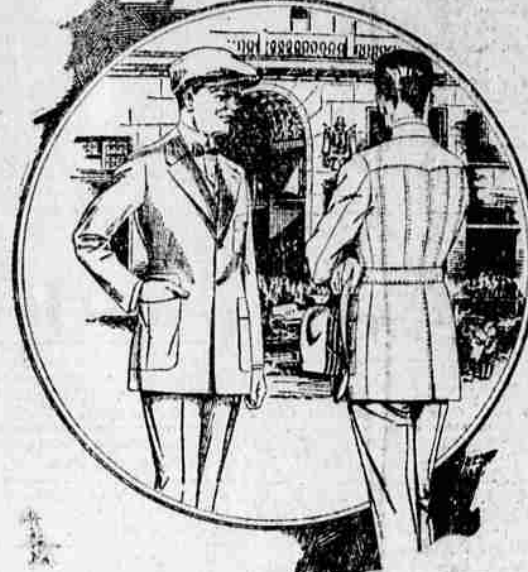
An American dancer is to wed a Scottish peer. Like so many others in this country, she just must have her Scotch.
