Release Of Prisoners Is Promised To Powers

(Continued from page 1)

The situation in China was both difficult and annoying and that the government here was doing everything possible to protect its nationals in China and to deal with the conditions there which have brought about chaos and banditry.

It was said to be President Harding's hope that the situation in China might be relieved by the investment of strong powers in the present admittedly weak central government. One way of aiding the Peking government to gain stability, it was suggested, would be the extension of necessary financial assistance by the international banking consortium. There was no intimation, however, that the Washington government would propose a step to the bankers interested in China.

No Words From Bandits.

PEKING, May 9.—Ominous lack of recent direct word from the bandits' stronghold in the hills back of Lin-Chang and various reports of captives wounded when used by their guards as shields against the volleys of pursuing government troops have filled the foreign colony here with grave fears for the safety of at least eight Americans and six or seven British, French and Italian hostages kidnapped by the Szechow train bandits early last Sunday morning.

The arrival at Tsianfu and Tientsin of men and women who were released by the brigands as messengers to arrange ransom, or who escaped from their captors, gave to the outside world a picture of peril, privation, hardship and brutal treatment that has added to the anxiety.

Women Still Missing.

WASHINGTON, May 9.—Official advice to the state department this afternoon said that Mrs. Seaton and Mrs. Auld were on the train attacked by the bandits. The dispatch conflicts with previous information from Manila, and said that the women were still missing.

WERE NOT ON TRAIN

MANILA, May 9.—Mrs. L. A. Seaton, of Berkeley, and Lillian Auld, of Eugene, reported probably captured by Chinese bandits, are safe in Shanghai, says a Shanghai cable. They were not on the train held up by the bandits.
