To Start Roadwork—
 The work of building the new road to Imnaha is to start about May 21, with twenty men and four or five teams engaged in the Forest Service crew. Forty-one thousand and seven hundred dollars is to be spent on the 12-12 miles of road, \$15,000 of this amount being contributed by the Forest Service. The county's share is the bond money voted for that purpose. Thirty thousand dollars will be used this year. This new road will be open practically all the year, and will eliminate the summit near the Buttes, and the Imnaha Hill of the present road.

A considerable amount of loose rock must be cut away in building the road down the canyon, and special machinery is being secured for the purpose. The road is to be nine feet wide on the side hill, and twelve feet on the level. The maximum grade is ten per cent, with an average of four per cent.—Walla-Walla Sun.

GIANT WIRELESS FOR FT. DOUGLAS
 (By Associated Press)
 SALT LAKE CITY, Utah, May 12.—One of the three large wireless stations planned by the United States army is to be erected at Fort Douglas here, according to announcement by army authorities. Robert Loughry, war department radio expert, is in Salt Lake City in connection with the project and tentative building plans are expected to be completed soon.

"The war department feels the need of more up-to-date stations than those now in operation," Mr. Loughry said in a recent interview. This is emphasized in the present number of relays now used to send a message from the Pacific Coast to Washington, D. C., or return.

"With the new station here and with relays—probably one here and one at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, and another further east—virtually simultaneous transcontinental communication will be available twenty-four hours in the day at all seasons of the year."
