TO PRESENT "HOUR HAND"

EUGENE, Ore.—(Special)—Based upon Swiss folk music and folklore, "The Hour Hand," an opera composed by Mrs. Anne Landsbury Beck of the University of Oregon school of music faculty, will be produced in Eugene May 1. Mrs. Beck obtained much of her folk songs while on a visit in Switzerland last summer, but has adapted them to bring about unity in the opera.

Mrs. Beck's father was a Swiss, a native of the Bernese Alps, which accounts in part for her interest in the traditions and folklore of the people of the European republic. The folk songs upon which Mrs. Beck has based the music of her opera were not obtainable in this country, and it was in little Alpine villages that she collected the tunes and songs woven into "The Hour Hand."
