

BUILD CITIES ON COLUMBIA

Astoria and Longview Are Being Rebuilt Along the Columbia River.

(By Associated Press)

PORTLAND, May 19.—On the banks of the historic Columbia river the unusual spectacle is now presented of two cities being built. One is Astoria, Oregon, near the mouth of the river, rising from the ashes of the fire of last December, and the other is Longview, Wash., the made-to-order city at the confluence of the Cowlitz and the Columbia, midway between Portland and Astoria.

While Astoria is profiting by the lessons taught by the fire and is constructing the new city on firm foundations of earth and concrete instead of wooden piling, as the founders had built in the early days, the army of men engaged in the building of Longview are being directed by city planners and architects who aim to make the dream of a model city come true.

Astoria, after months of clearing away of debris and discussion as to the best method of rebuilding, is now well on the way toward realization of a newer and better city, and several substantial structures are under way or projected.

Longview, at the present time, presents an interesting spectacle. Laid out on a plan resembling Washington, D. C., the thoroughfares are broad and radiate from a civic center. The streets have been graded and paving is to start before long. Already a large department store has been erected and a story book hotel will be ready in July.

Hundreds of small dwellings for the lumber mill hands have been erected in one section of the city, but instead of the uniformity usual in such structures the ordinary mill towns there are put up according to thirty different designs which are so interspersed as to avoid any impression of monotony. Variety in paint colors also is employed. There are also a large "detention" for the unmarried mill hands, resembling barracks at an army post.

Longview also boasts of a daily newspaper. Housed in a temporary wooden structure is an up-to-date plant with two Linotype machines, press, folder, job press, small cutting outfit, and other equipment to match. The Longview News, of which Ralph Tennal is editor, receives The Associated Press service, and the circulation has grown so rapidly in the short time the paper has been published that already it has a carrier force of nearly twenty boys. Besides its subscribers in Longview, the News circulates extensively in Kelso, which adjoins the Longview townsite.

Already the News is preparing for the erection of a permanent building of attractive style.

Construction of the huge lumber mill has not yet been started. Extensive docks are to be built along the waterfront on the Columbia and Cowlitz rivers, according to announced plans. The mill, when running, is to employ 4,000 men, according to the lumber company backing the enterprise.

SALMON FLEET ALASKA BOUND

SAN FRANCISCO, May 19.—The salmon fishing fleet has cleared the Golden Gate and the sturdy little ships are now en route to Bristol Bay, Alaska, where the season opens July 1. Red salmon fishing in Bristol Bay lasts only thirty days, and the ships of the various canning companies will be concentrated in the bay until August 1.

Last year the fleet of 800 vessels in the Alaskan waters brought a pack

to the canneries valued at nearly \$40,000,000. More than \$70,000,000 is invested in the Alaska salmon industry, and 27,500 persons are normally engaged in the work of fishing and canning.

A total of 7,240,185 cases of salmon were caught last year, distributed as follows: Alaska, 4,501,128; British Columbia, 1,200,326; Siberia, 718,184; Columbia River, 392,174; Puget Sound, 248,729, and outside streams, 89,344.

Since 1878 the canned salmon pack in Alaska has reached 86,271,075 cases. The next largest catch is 29,882,971 cases from British Columbia since 1878, and 22,784,458 from the Puget Sound since 1877. The Columbia river has yielded 22,541,101 cases since 1869.

LEGAL SUCCOR FOR MEXICANS PLANNED

TUCSON, Ariz., May 19.—Announcement of definite plans for the organization of a league for the defense of Mexicans charged with vio-

lation of the laws of the United States, and launching of a drive to secure 5,000 members within a period of two months, was made here recently by F. E. Schmidt, secretary to Henry V. Anaya, former Mexican consul here and now grand secretary of the Alianza Hispano-Americana. Organization of the league, declares the secretary, is for the purpose of providing a legal defense to which Mexicans are entitled when charged with violation of the laws of this country. Prejudice against Mexicans in criminal cases has, in the past, caused the judgments against them to be particularly heavy. Mr. Schmidt indicated.
