GUARD CALLED OUT

SALEM, Ore., May 23.—State-wide mobilization of the National Guard was ordered here early tonight by Brigadier-General George A. White, adjutant general of the state. Orders calling the entire force to the colors were sent out by telegraph without preliminary notice to the citizen soldiers. The fact became known here only when members of the Salem infantry company began hurrying to the armory shortly after 8 p. m.

Test of the present efficiency of the national guard under a new assembly plan recently put out by General White caused the order, it was said by those close to the adjutant-general's office.

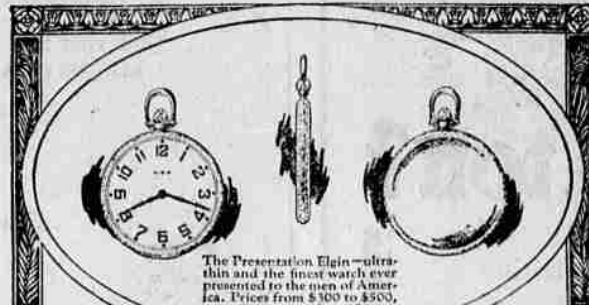
