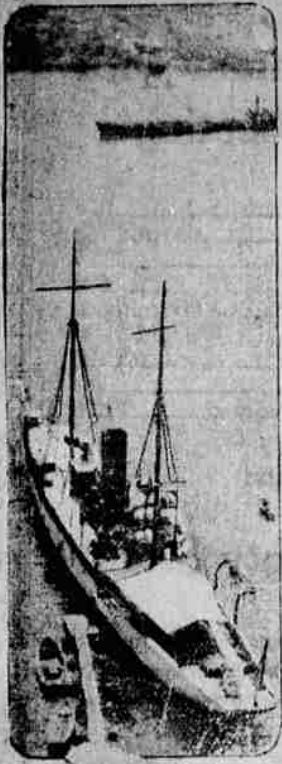


Resting Easy
