HAINES, Ore., June 1.—The Haines Stampede management yesterday gambled with the weather man, and lost. The entire program however, was up to expectations, and with good weather from now on attendance records should be broken, for some of the best riders in the country are on the program.

The second annual Haines Stampede officially opened with a bang when the parade, headed by the 26 piece cowboy band made its way to the grounds. All facilities are reported to be crowded to the limit with some of the best racing stock on the coast.

Good Races.

In the free for all races, Trixie Water on Lady Night won first place, Trix Frazier on Rainbow and Reed on Charles Chaplin placed next. Hobler on Bossy placed first in the saddle horse race, with Kennedy on Red, second.

In the cowboy pony race, Stephens on Cream, won, with Church on South and Tony on Beck placing next.

The Walters string of horses won first in the quick change relay, and the Red Sales placed second.

Red was first in the standing Roman race. Byers was second.

The Roman chariot race proved a thriller, Church winning, with Byers second.

All the bucking contests were carried over until today, which is Union county day.

During the evenings, the crowds will be entertained by two shows and two dance floors.

vision and direction of the city manager. For violation of this act the penalty is not less than \$5 fine and not more than \$100, or imprisonment in the city jail one day for each \$2 of such fine not to exceed 20 days. The ordinance carried an emergency clause making it immediately effective.

Repair Reservoir.

A contract was authorized with the Albertson-Cornell Brothers and Welch Corporation for the repair of the local reservoir, by lining with reinforced granite.

Papers were submitted to the commission regarding the Oro Dell overhead crossing, which would settle the question of the overhead to all concerned.

The commission favored the laying of two plank walks from Z avenue to the river along the west side of Spruce street for the convenience of residents during Chautauqua week, June 23-28, inclusive, the walks to be constructed before the chautauqua opens.
