CHURCHES RALLY TO WORLD COURT

WASHINGTON, June 2.—A call to 125,000 congregations in America to rally to the support of President Harding's proposal that the United States enter the permanent court of international justice, was issued here Thursday by the Federated Council of the Churches of Christ in America.

"A day of great decision for our country and the world has now arrived," says the call, adding that the issue which the world court presents embodies the age-long conflict between law and force.

"Today, around the earth," the message continues, "the people know that if nations are to survive they must subject their individual wills to established processes of law, their individual interest to the welfare of all mankind. All that the Christian church itself has built up in the hearts and minds of people through centuries of effort hangs in the balance."

"For war, in the future, aided by the power of science, simply means self-destruction. This appeal to the sword can be abolished by only one means, the means already found within the state—by building up an appeal to law instead. That is exactly the purpose of the permanent court of international justice. In it we see a great advance in the long struggle of man to civilize himself."

"The court is not a 'private' court of the league of nations. By a decision of the council of the league on May 12, 1922, it has been opened to all the world. In most cases party to a dispute must consent before the court can deal with the dispute. An optional clause in the treaty establishing the court has now been ratified in most cases upon conditions of reciprocity by 18 states, giving the court jurisdiction of every dispute between these states wherein is involved any question of international law, of interpretation of a treaty or of a breach of an international obligation."

Notice is hereby given to all whom it may concern that the Commission of the City of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, proposes and intends to improve Improvement District No. 125 in the City of La Grande, Oregon, in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted by the Commission, and that the report of the committee on estimates for said improvement is now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of La Grande, Oregon; that the said Commission has set Wednesday, the 13th day of June, 1923, at 7:30 o'clock p. m., of said day, at the Commission Room in the City Building in La Grande, Oregon, as the time and place when and

where said Commission will meet and hear and determine all objections, remonstrances and claims of grievance of any persons against said proposed improvement and the proposed assessment therefor against the property to be benefited thereby in said district.

That the said proposed improvement will consist of grading the following named streets to the proper subgrade between curb lines and constructing therein hard surface pavement thirty (30) feet in width between curb lines on Spruce Street from the north property line of Adams Avenue to the north property line of Washington Avenue, including all of the street intersection at Adams Avenue not now paved; and by constructing hard surface pavement on Tenth Street from a point 7 feet south of the north line of M Avenue to the south property line of Washington Avenue, thirty (30) feet in width between curb lines, including all of the intersection at Tenth Street not now paved; and by constructing hard surface pavement on N Avenue from the west property line of Tenth Street to the east property line of Fourth Street, forty (40) feet in width between curb lines, with full street intersections, excepting Sixth Street intersection; and by constructing hard surface pavement on Eighth Street from the south property line of M Avenue to the south property line of Pennsylvania Avenue, forty (40) feet in width between curb lines; and by constructing hard surface pavement at all alley intersections and driveways; and also by constructing sidewalks where same are not in place, combination curbs and gutters where same are not in place, concrete gutters where curbs are in place, catch basins, manholes, and by laying sewer pipes and manhole frames and covers on the above named streets, to-wit: N Avenue from the west property line of Tenth Street to the east property line of Fourth Street; Spruce Street from the north property line of Adams Avenue to the north property line of Washington Avenue; Tenth Street from a point 7 feet south of the north line of M Avenue to the south property line of Washington Avenue; Eighth Street from the south property line of M Avenue to the south property line of Pennsylvania Avenue; Ninth Street from the north property line of N Avenue to the south property line of O Avenue, all located in Coggan's and Chaplin's Additions to the City of La Grande.

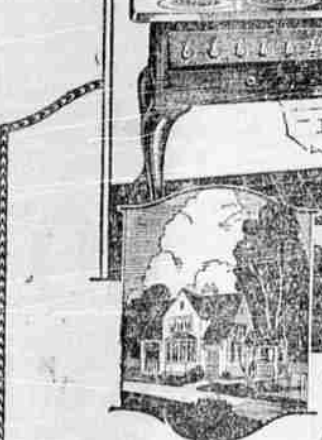
