clared it would effectively rid the state of "wild cat" agents. The law provides that no company shall sell, offer for sale or take subscription upon any security of its own issue until a permit has been obtained from the secretary of state and no broker may act as the agent of any company that has not been licensed under a permit, nor may any broker sell securities who has not obtained a certificate from the secretary of state. All companies desiring to issue or sell securities must furnish the secretary with data, including lists of officers, trustees and directors, a statement of assets and liabilities, the location of offices, the plan upon which it is proposed to transact business, and copies of all literature, prospectus and of any security issued.

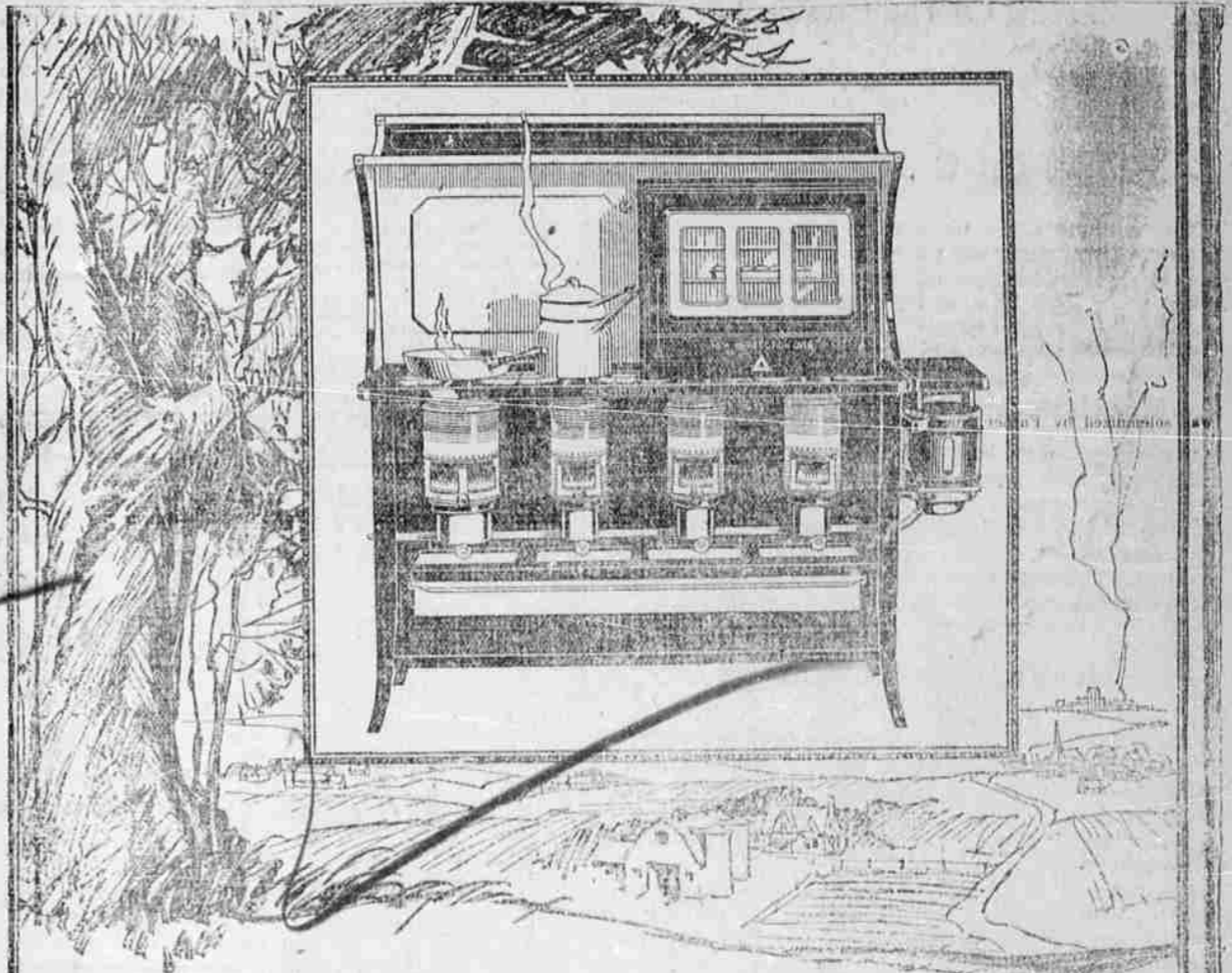
