DEMAND FOR ONE TON TRUCKS IS DOUBLING SALES

DETROIT, Mich., June 7.—Motorization of delivery and hauling systems in the cities and through agricultural sections where improved highways have greatly facilitated transportation continues to increase at a rapid pace.
One-ton trucks still lead in popularity by a wide margin.
This is strikingly shown in the sale of Ford trucks, the demand for which has more than doubled the sales of a year ago.

During the first four months of this year, the Ford Motor Company delivered at retail in the United States a total of 59,973 trucks, 31,652 more than were sold during the same period last year.

The Ford Motor Company during the week ending Tuesday, May 15, set up a new production record by turning out 29,284 cars and trucks for domestic use. It is announced by The Ford News. This exceeds by 250 the previous high weekly record of 28,934 established the week before.

The highest day of the last week was May 9 when a new daily production mark of 6,615 cars and trucks was reached.

At River Rouge the Fordson Tractor plant production for the week was 2,940.
The Lincoln division of the company produced 155 cars during the week ending Tuesday.

NEAR RIOT AT ALIEN SCHOOL

HONOLULU, T. H., June 7.—The Kakaako Japanese language school here recently became the scene of a near riot when the so-called radical element of the school obtained forcible possession of the building by ejecting five members of the so-called conservative group and its attorney.

The radical group desires to close the school and to join in the pending litigation brought by thirteen other alien schools to test the constitutionality of the Clark act, adopted by the last legislature, to regulate alien language schools. The conservative element desires to keep the school open, to refrain from joining the litigation and to obey the terms of the Clark act. The disturbance arose when the radical and conservative groups met at the school and resulted in the victory for the radicals.

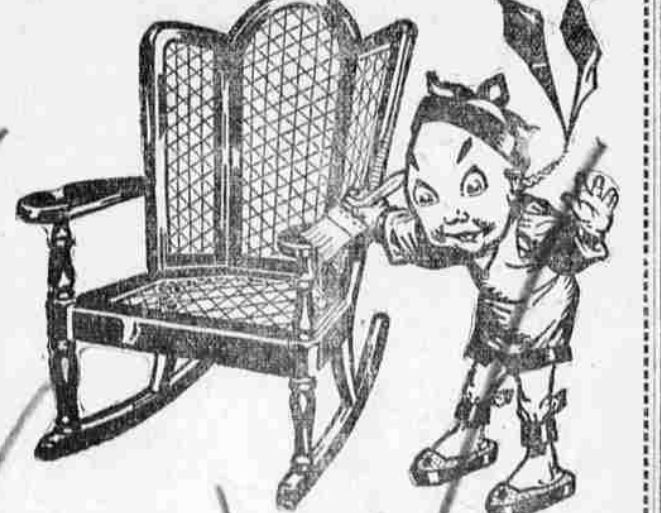
