"DR. CALIGARI" TODAY ONLY

Prof. Einstein, who knows more about the universe than most of us can understand, is said to have added a new dimension to scientist's conception of the universe. But a great many more people than are interested in the Einstein theory will be interested to hear that someone has added a new dimension to the motion picture.

"The Cabinet of Dr. Caligari," a sensational European picture which comes to the Sherry Theatre today only has been created by the "expressionist" artist who designed the sets in an entirely original manner. Ordinarily, there are only two dimensions to a motion picture: length and height, and it remained for "The Cabinet of Dr. Caligari" to show us that it is possible to add to the screen a third dimension - thickness, that is, depth.
