## Arrangements For Bout Are Announced

### Mike Collins Gives Out Details of Gibbons-Dempsey Championship Fight.

GREAT FALLS, Mont., June 22.—Three 10 round bouts will precede the Jack Dempsey-Tom Gibbons heavyweight championship contest at Shelby, Mont., July 4. Mike Collins, watchmaker for the championship contest, announced here Thursday night.

The boxing carnival will get under way promptly at 12 o'clock noon with the first preliminaries, and Gibbons and Dempsey are scheduled to get into the ring promptly at 8 p. m. Mountain standard time. Matchmaker Collins expects that he will have a leeway of probably a half hour provided all the preliminaries go to the limit, before Dempsey and the St. Paul challenger crawl thru the ropes.

Jimmy Delaney, the St. Paul light heavyweight, working in Gibbons' camp, will meet Jack Burke of Pittsburg, one of Dempsey's sparring partners in one of the 10-round bouts, while Thillie ("Kid") Herman of Los Angeles, also of the Gibbons camp, will meet Joe Simonich of Butte, in another preliminary. These are welterweights. The third preliminary probably will be between Lackey Morrow of Portland, Ore., and Dandy Dillon, a Minneapolis featherweight.

Heavyweight bouts will be engaged, Collins said, to entertain the crowd from the time the arena is opened. The Scottish Highlanders of Calgary, Alta., 80 in number, will be stationed on one side of the arena while the Elks state band of 100 pieces will be located in another section.

Collins conferred Thursday with representatives of several motion picture concerns in regard to taking movies of the championship fight, but reached no decision. The pictures will be rushed into Canada for development as no concern within a 1000 miles of Shelby has facilities for doing the work.

Dempsey's training camp, due to the violent rain storm of Wednesday, was in camp here Thursday and the champion was forced to suspend all training activities. The fighting system at the camp was out of commission and the indoor gymnasium was so badly rain-soaked that working there was out of the question.

The champion remained in his quarters, playing cards and listening to jazz tunes of a phonograph. His only exercise was a brief session at shadow boxing to keep his muscles loosened.

Manager Jack Kearnes welcomed the day of rest as he declared Dempsey was ready to go into the ring and that a day of idleness would do Dempsey no harm, in fact, he believed it would help his condition.

ASCOT-HEATH, Eng., June 22.—Harley's Happy Man, by Desman, out of Happy Child, won the gold cup of 200 pounds with 3500 pounds added, run here Thursday. Lord Peck's Silvan was second and Marlo Peck's Flechois, third. Eight horses ran. Happy man was quoted at 7 to 4 against in the betting; Silvan 10 to 1 and Peck's 100 to 8 against.

## THY TO MEET YOKEL


