# KLAN TO GIVE W. C. T. U. SUM

### \$50,000 Gift to W. C. T. U. Children's Farm Home Is Voted by Oregon Ku Klux Klan.

PORTLAND, June 28.—The W. C. T. U. Children's Farm home is to be given \$50,000 by the Oregon Ku Klux Klan, according to a decision reached at the Klan convention now being held here in the Pythian temple. Len A. Deverb, editor of the Western American and publicity manager of the Klan, made the announcement of the action.

The fund was voted following an address before the klansmen by Mrs. Ada Ulrich of the W. C. T. U. and Superintendent Webb of the Children's Farm home. The donation represents the gift of all the klans in the state and it is said that the funds are at hand and will be ready for delivery to the W. C. T. U. in the immediate future.

From one to three delegates from every county in the state attended the convention here, exalted cyclops, cyclops, kligrapps and a few klagles. Luther I. Powell of Seattle, king klegale in charge of Washington and Idaho, attended the session.

Fred A. Gifford, grand dragon of the Oregon Klan and in charge of the western division, addressed the convention, discussing the national session recently held in Washington, D. C. Mr. Gifford was re-elected grand dragon for Oregon. He expects to leave soon for the Atlantic coast on business for the Klan. Officers for a number of the klans in different parts of the state were elected.

Following the open session and election, a business session was held which included the outlining of detailed plans for the conduct of the Klan in Oregon and for the reorganization of the women's auxiliary, the Ladies of the Ku Klux Klan, in line with agreements reached by the national convention.

The Ku Klux Klan will not sponsor any movement to recall Governor Pierce, Mr. Gifford announced to the convention Monday night. The action in effect was the grand dragon's formal refusal to sanction the plans of some members of the Klan, taken during his absence, to put the recall machinery into motion.

The Klan, Mr. Gifford told the delegates from all parts of the state, will not undertake a recall until some "overt act" should be performed by the state executive which patently justify such action. He indicated that while the Klan might not be satisfied with the patronage awards made by the governor and not agree with the wisdom of the executive appointments, he did not believe that the recall plans were warranted.

Full support of the grand dragon's decision was voiced by the members of the invisible empire.

### ALICEL GIRL NAMED SCIENCE CLUB HEAD

LEWISTON, Idaho, June 28.—Ina Lee Watkins, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. H. C. Watkins, of Alicel, Oregon, a member of the Lewiston Normal has been elected secretary of the Science Club.

Election to this club is considered the highest honor that can come to a normal-school student as the membership is limited to those who manifest the highest qualities of scholarship, character and leadership.

Miss Watkins is vice-president of the Gaillohi Club and also received second prize in a dramatic contest in a class of twelve.

# POISON TAKEN FROM REPTILES

BROWNVILLE, Tex., June 28.—Three glass jars, hermetically sealed, each filled with yellowish crystals, repose on a shelf in the office of W. A. ("Snake") King, at "Snakeville," on the outskirts of Brownsville. The crystals in each jar represent the collection of poison from approximately 8,000 rattlesnakes, and, according to Mr. King, there is enough poison in the jars to kill several regiments, if it were properly applied.

King annually buys and sells thousands of rattlesnakes, and at "Snakeville" there are at all times hundreds of rattlers of all sizes and descriptions. For several years he has been collecting poison from the reptiles.

It is a curious fact, King points out, that the poison used to produce the antitoxin works well only when it comes from the family of snakes from which the bite has come. In the case of a rattlesnake bite, King asserts, the serum used is made from the blood of a horse inoculated with rattlesnake poison injected into the blood as near and as soon after the bite as possible.

When the snake farm at San Paulo, Brazil, was established by the Brazilian government, and placed in the hands of advanced scientists, King was asked by them for some crystals and antitoxin. King supplied several quarts of the crystals, representing the collection from about 25,000 rattlesnakes.
