tutional bar, perhaps not unwisely, in nearly all the states, on the teaching of religion in tax-supported schools, colleges and universities. As a result the study of religion and ethics has been too much neglected; education has become increasingly utilitarian and materialistic. The graduates of our tax-supported institutions are more and more becoming neither religious nor irreligious, but simply non-religious. "It is proposed, through schools of religion, to give instruction in the history, literature and philosophy of religion and in the fundamental principles underlying all religion; for it has been and is bound to be an important factor in private and public life and cannot safely be ignored in any system of education which aims to develop character. "No tax money will be used to support the schools of religion, and they are to be free from sectarianism and denominationalism. "The National Council is co-operating with local forces in Michigan in establishing at Ann Arbor, the seat of the University of Michigan, with its 10,000 or more students, the first fully equipped school of religion. It is expected that other similar schools will be developed at other great educational centers. "The entire movement is inspired by the widespread conviction that something essential is lacking in our modern civilization, and that the best way to meet the demands of youth for practical philosophy of life is to enable them to estimate rightly the relative value of the spiritual and of the material life; and that this task can be accomplished most effectively in the great educational centers."
