CURFEW NOT TO BLOW TONIGHT

VALE, July 17.—The last relic of bygone days when the town crier was the official medium of publicity and curfew told the big majority of the people—those without clocks—that it was time to go to bed, is to be done away with in Vale.

Beginning Monday, curfew will ring—or blow—no more in Vale and fond parents will have no excuse for not personally seeing that their children are home at the proper time. This is in compliance with a resolution passed at the regular council meeting recently.

But to provide a daily test to the fire siren to see that it is in good working order, a blast will be blown each day at 12 o'clock noon. An siren can be heard for several miles around Vale, the noon blast will be of some benefit as a chronometer firemen in Vale are warned to keep their shoes on next Monday when the siren bursts forth in song.

Clubs Will Help, On.

WALLA WALLA, Wann, July 16.—Various civic organizations of the city will take over portions of the programme of work at a recently adopted by the Commercial club. This was decided today at a meeting of the directors of the Commercial club with representatives of the other bodies. This will be stated, insure definite results and do away with conflicting efforts.

The Commercial club will continue to handle agriculture, roads irrigation, athletic field inter-community lion, freight rates, new hotel, tour, relation and erection of a cannery.
