### Silver Output Slackening.

BUTTE, Mont., July 23.—Discontinuance of governmental purchases of silver under the Pittman act has resulted in the closing of some mines in western Montana and the reduction of working forces in others. The silver properties the effect has been drop in price from approximately \$1

an ounce to around sixty-five cents, occasioned by the reversion from the government's fixed to that prevailing in the open market, has not seriously affected many mines in the Butte district proper where silver is generally only a by-product. In outlying districts where there are exclusively silver properties the effect has been felt keenly.

### LOTTERY BASED ON MANY WORDS

SAN FRANCISCO, Calif., July 23.—Lotteries are plays on words taken from the greatest of Chinese classics, the Tsing Tse Mun, according to visitors to San Francisco's Chinatown who have tried their luck at the fickle game, and some of whom have come away with only the taste of how lotteries originated.

Long ago, in the moon age, goes the story, there dwelt in a verdant Chinese province a ruler gifted but avaricious. His greed made him cruel, his subjects soon were oppressed and there were murmurs of revolt. Chief among the rebels was a young lord who had married a beautiful poetess. The young lord's great fortune, his charming wife and his zeal for the ancient rights of the people brought him quickly to the ruler's unfavorable notice. He was placed in jail and was told to prepare to have his head chopped off. In spite of her distraction the young wife did not lose courage. She obtained audience with the despot and, instead of begging for her husband's freedom, she justified his acts and demanded his freedom in the name of truth and law.

The ruler was intrigued. None other had dared stand so boldly before him. So he made her a proposition. "Go home," he said, "and write a poem. It must be of a thousand words. It must be lovely as a flower, logical as life and death, linked together as a chain, and no word in it may be repeated. If you can do this I shall liberate your lord. If you do not, you must share the fate that awaits him."

And so from her hope, her love and her courage, she found inspiration for the greatest of Chinese classics, the Tsing Tse Mun. Its thousand characters are to Chinese what the alphabet or the multiplication table is to an American.

Their distinctness from each other and from all other characters soon attracted gamblers who sought different symbols. And now the thirty characters of a Chinese lottery ticket are chosen from a poem.

### Wallowa May Get Park And Community Building

WALLOWA, July 23.—Several important matters were taken up at the meeting of the City Council recently. All the members were present except J. O. Kiddle.

The matter of the city park was discussed, and it was decided to work out a proposition for the sale of the property. The seven-acre tract, which lies near the Riverside addition, has a considerable amount of timber on it, and as the land would be useful, it is hoped that a good price can be secured.

The civic building for the housing of the library, council rooms, fire truck, and jail was discussed favorably and the opinion was very favorable for its erection this year. It is believed that by a building and loan proposition the structure can be built without an additional burden to the taxpayers.

### BEAUSEANT FOR L. A. TEMPLARS

LOS ANGELES, July 23.—Approximately 100,000 persons are expected to line the sides of Hollywood Bowl, a natural amphitheater in the hills of Hollywood, when President Harding appears there August 3 to present to Hollywood Commandery No. 56, Knights of Templar, the international traveling beauseant of the order. Masons from all parts of California will be present at the ceremony, which will be preceded by a parade of twelve bands and thousands of Knights Templar in full regalia. The international traveling beauseant is a banner symbolic of the

great lodge. The original banner was carried in the Crusades by the first Knights Templar. The present beauseant originated in the priory of Canada and was started on its trip around the world when it was presented to the commandery at Buffalo. From there it went to Washington and Philadelphia and then to President Harding's home commandery at Marion, Ohio.

### KLAN TO STAGE BIG CEREMONIAL

An open air ceremonial will be staged in La Grande by the La Grande Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, according to announcements made by officers of the order today. Where the ceremonial will be held was not made public but "follow the parade and you will find the site" was their only declaration as to where the ceremonial will be. The public is invited to the affair. The parade will be held in the business section of La Grande about nine o'clock Wednesday evening, July 25. According to Klansmen a class of applicants at this time will be initiated into the mysteries of the organization.

### Caught Fish and Gophers By Same Casting Method

SPOKANE, Wash., July 23.—The strangest catch reported here for some time was that of Johnny Stewart, billiard instructor of the Spokane Amateur Athletic club, who claims he caught the limit of cutthroat trout and half a dozen gophers all with the same tackle, rod, reel, and flies, at Bull river, Montana.

"While walking along the Bull river shore I noticed that gophers were plentiful," Stewart explained upon his return.
