Evans Defeats Sweetser. CLEVELAND, July 28.—Missing an 18 putt on the second extra hole after running up a second extra hole after the green all day and making many long ones, Friday post Jose Sweetser, national champion, his golf match with Chick Evans in the semi-finals at Mayfield club of the western amateur championship which Evans was defending for the seventh time.
