REFUGEES ARE FLOCKING IN

Berlin Is the Mecca for All Sorts of Political Agitators and Refugees.

BERLIN, July 15 (By Mail)—Germany is rapidly displacing Switzerland as a center for all sorts of political agitators and refugees. They are attracted here by the smiling mark and the tolerant attitude of the government. Switzerland rapidly is losing favor with radicals of all sorts. Persians, Turks, Indians, Egyptians, Arabs and Tunisians are so numerous in this city that they have united in the erection of a Mohammedan mosque in one of the best residential sections of west Berlin.

Mohammedanism gained considerable foothold in Germany during the war. Many Mohammedans who were fighting with the Russian forces were taken prisoners by the Germans, or voluntarily gave themselves into German hands, because they did not wish to fight against the Islamic brothers, the Turks. These Mohammedans were treated with great consideration by the Germans, who placed them in a camp at Wilmersdorf, a Berlin suburb. A mosque was erected there for them, and they were given every opportunity to live in accordance with their religion. In fact,

they were guests of Germany, rather than prisoners.

The missionary who is directing the construction of the new mosque belongs to an Indian Islamic movement which has over 500,000 adherents and is seeking to make the followers of Islam "lost Christians" without altering in any way the teachings of the Koran. These reformers are called Ahmadiyah, and seek to win their fellow-religionists away from the blind acceptance of the phrase, "Whatever happens is the will of Allah." In other words, they would persuade Mohammedans throughout the world that they need not submit to Christian domination, that a holy war is capable of freeing Islam to the followers of the true faith will throw off the spirit of the east and act with greater independence.

England Won't Keep Her Art.

LONDON, July 16 (By Mail)—It is not intended to take any legislative measures to keep works of art, famous books and pictures in this country. Sir W. Joynson Hicks, financial secretary to the treasury, told a questioner in the House of Commons recently.

The questioner referred to measures proposed by the House of Commons, whereby such treasures, which might otherwise be sold to America, might come instead to national or municipal collections at a fair valuation. The secretary said the question had been considered by the trustees of the National Gallery, who advised the government against any such legislation.

DEPOT TO HAVE JAIL AND MOVIE

CHICAGO, Aug. 2.—Every thing from jail to movie theatre is provided for in plans of the main building of the new union station here, construction of which already is under way.

The miniature jail has been designed for the safe keeping of prisoners being transported from one city to another for trial. In the basement, the plan show, will be a laundry for the use of immigrant women. In another section of the building plans have been made for the installation of a morgue.

A dispensary and hospital to care for other railway employees or for travelers will be located in another section.

Among the other features planned for the station will be dry goods and wearing apparel stores, florists' shops and the latest devices for announcing the arrival and departure of trains. The total cost of the main building will be \$10,000,000 and the construction work will take 18 months.

Favors Conscription to Solve Servant Problem

LONDON, Aug. 2.—Conscription of English women for domestic service has been urged.

The suggestion has been met with an uproar from the feminine portion of the population, and there is little fear that it will ever be considered seriously by legislators.

"I think there should be conscription for domestic training," Mrs. E. A. Whit told the Government inquiry on the lack of domestic servants.

"Every woman should have a certificate of six months' training," she continued, testifying before the Ministry of Labor Commission, which is striving to determine the reason for the serious shortage of domestic help in England.

Training centres throughout England for all women, to teach them how to run homes and how to live, were advocated by Mrs. Whit, who declared that at the present time girls look upon home work as something to be avoided. She is an authority on domestic service in North England.

"Misses want more time to devote to local matters. If they do not spend their time at golf and tennis they have the committee habit," she said.

"Eliminating their mistresses, the number of domestic servants would be increased," she said.

"Every woman in England should have a domestic training certificate."

Mrs. Whit declared, "and every woman should be forced to take six months' training in domestic science."

"Men could make the domestic girl popular by marrying her," she declared.
