FRANCE HAS A NEW KIND FUEL

(By Associated Press)
 PARIS, Aug. 2.—Alcohol and gasoline, mixed in equal quantities, will be put on the market as the French "national fuel" in October.

Long tests and a multitude of scientific sessions finally evolved this mixture as better than straight gasoline and a great forward step in "freeing France from foreign petroleum domination," a phrase often used in parliament.

France produces much alcohol, used largely in poor country homes for their limited cooking, and in industry. This production, it is held, can be increased many fold, so that the country need no longer be dependent upon the heavy importations of petroleum that became a serious problem during the war and

is blamed now for helping to keep down the franc.

Scientific commissions have decided half alcohol and half gasoline will not injure an automobile motor, will not increase the consumption, and will give greater flexibility with some increase in power. The cost of the new fuel is a matter of controversy. It is contended by its friends that competition will settle the question of price satisfactorily.

Many other combinations of alcohol, gasoline, kerosene and crude oil have been tried. A test made by a government car recently gave good results with 70 per cent alcohol and 30 per cent kerosene.

Gasoline, however, will remain the fuel for army airplanes for the present. The government hopes eventually to find a suitable fuel for its big air force, but the aviation service prefers to watch the work of the new fuel and dry land before running any new risk of stalled motors in the clouds.

It must be conceded, however, that few states are erected to men who mind their own business and have no enemies.

STEPTOE BUTTE A STATE PARK

 COLEMAN, Wash., August 2.—Steptoe butte, nine miles north of Colfax, noted in the history of the Inland Empire as the site of Colonel Steptoe's battle with the Indians 65 years ago, will be made a state park if efforts of prominent men of this district bear fruit.

The butte is said to be but 300 feet lower than Mount Spokane and to command an inspiring view of the entire Palouse wheat country. The backers of the movement to make it a state park feel that eastern tourists would be attracted by this kind of scenery. The construction of a road to the top of the butte is one of the chief problems confronting the park enthusiasts at present.

On May 17, 1853, Colonel Steptoe, then campaigning against the Indians, was marching with part of his command toward Colville when they were attacked by a large force. Reporting the battle, Colonel Steptoe wrote:

"About half an hour after this, Captain Taylor was brought in mortally wounded, upon which I immediately took possession of a convenient height (Steptoe butte) and halted. There the fight continued with unabated activity, the Indians occupying the neighboring heights and working themselves along to pick off our men."

That night the small frontier army retreated from the butte to the Snake river, to the south.

Health Plan Adopted.
 MAIRSHFIELD, Or., Aug. 2.—The Coos County Health association intends to carry out the 100 per cent health programme as embodied in the Rockefeller foundation plan of adding to the payment of part of a county's expense which follows the foundation suggestions. The Coos county plans were upset and the arrangements include engaging a new physician for that part of the work. A competent man who will spend his time for such work is difficult to find, as most physicians make considerably more in regular practice. Two nurses are now engaged in the work.—Mrs. Deadrich and Miss White.

of Agriculture, in a statement issued here. Losses due to insect attacks upon living trees and crude, finished and utilized forest products are estimated by the forest service at \$130,000,000 annually.

The western pine beetle, the gypsy moth, the chestnut blight and the white-pine blister rust are the most damaging of the insects and diseases which are now attacking the trees and forest products, according to the forest service.

"By far the most serious menace of disease to forest crops at the present time lies in the imported epidemic," states the forest service. "The chestnut blight, imported from eastern Asia on nursery stock in the early nineties, has all but exterminated this useful tree throughout its northern range. Quarantines of foreign tree nursery stock, the only effective means of preventing such diseases, have only recently been put in force. The most important example of this type of disease is the white-pine blister rust. Introduced from Europe within the last twenty years, it is now widespread through the north range of the eastern white pine, and has recently been found extensively in British Columbia and, to a limited extent, in Washington on the western white pine. The very existence of the western white and sugar pine forests is threatened."
