## BLIND READERS HAVE VOLUMES

CHICAGO, Aug. 8.—In an effort to reach every sightless person in this part of the country, the collection of books for the blind in the public library here has become one of the largest in the United States, according to Nathan R. Levin, assistant librarian of the Chicago Public Library.

The blind from nearly every state in the Mississippi valley patronize this collection, because of its ready

accessibility, declares Edward Peterson, in charge of the work. Anybody can apply for a loan, and the government permits the books to be sent out in franked envelopes. The number of available volumes in raised printing is comparatively small. It is said, but the Chicago library, with 3,500 books, claims to have virtually everything ever published for the benefit of sightless people.

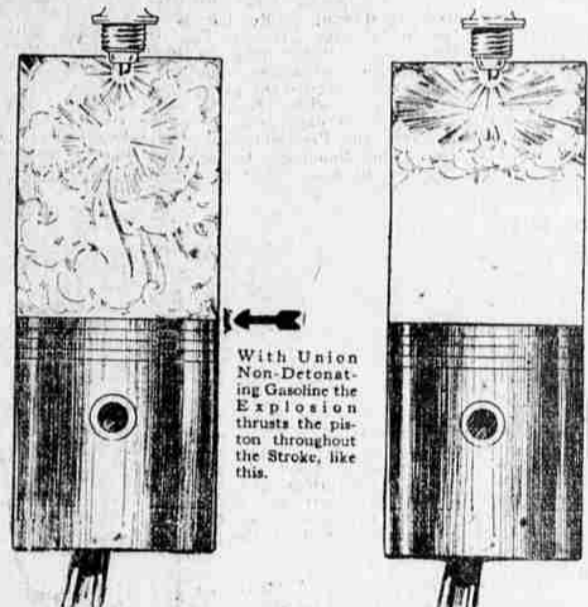
