OREGON WELL SHOWN IN THE PAGEANT FILM

Beauties of State Set Forth—President Harding Seen at Meacham.

Let those who think they must go to far away islands for pretty scenes, or to the soft magnolia-blossomed southern for beautiful moonlight nights banish the thought and look to Oregon for every setting that appeals to one who loves nature for a motion picture.

This statement is proven by the film now being shown at the Star which depicts not only the Old Oregon Trail Pageant scenes showing President and Mrs. Harding along with all who took part in the celebration as well as those who attended it on July 3rd, but also shows Portland scenes during the Rose show exhibits beautiful settings along the Columbia river, put forth on the screen the successful fishermen on the Deschutes, and in fact brings out the natural beauty of the state in a pronounced manner as well as giving a glimpse of the industrial Oregon.

Nothing in the picture pleased the large audience last night as much as the pictures of the Meacham celebration showing President and Mrs. Harding in the old stage coach and six horses driven by Joe Woods. In that portion of the picture, people were prominent, in fact it was a picture of the show the three towns put on for the President and it was a good show.

The Oregon Trail picture will be shown again tonight.

COUNTY JAIL IS POPULAR

A reporter on the staff of the Evening Observer today, wondering if the "crime wave" had decreased or increased in Union county during the past year, visited the county jail and discovered several interesting facts—facts that would tend to show that if the criminals are not more active this year, that at least a greater share of them are being captured by the officers.

A check of the prisoners in the county jail this month, to date, shows that the register numbers 14. Last year at this time only one dozen men were behind the county bars.

Further inquiry resulted in ascertaining that a total of 55 men had inhabited the county hotel during the period of January 1 to August 1, 1922, and that 59 had looked out from the inside during the period of January 1 to August 1, 1923.

Five men are in the county jail at the present time, for various offenses. The greater number of men jailed for violating the laws were convicted of burglary, larceny or "paper hanging," which is the sheriff's way of indicating the terms of forgery, check raising and the like. Moonshine cases are also fairly numerous.

TO ERECT OIL DERRICK SOON

According to F. C. Siddall, president of the Union County Oil company, a concern recently organized in Oregon for the purpose of prospecting for oil and gas in Union county, an 84-foot derrick has been ordered from a local supply company and will be erected on the site of the initial well in the Mt. Glenn district.

He said the timber would be hauled to the location and he expects to let the contract for erecting the derrick within a few days. It is to be a standard rig, according to the president, and the reason for selecting the location he did for a test well is due to a report on the geology of the valley made by a geologist by the name of Vitters.

While we cannot guarantee we will strike oil we intend to give the district an accurate and thorough test," said Mr. Siddall today. "Should gas in commercial quantities be obtained we have a market for it. In this valley the heavy bed of volcanic material has largely been removed so that drilling into the underlying strata will not require so great an expenditure. Also some of the older sediments are exposed and structure conditions can to a measure be determined. With the assurance of Geologist Vitters on the formations here we are optimistic about the out come."
