BOTH JAPAN, CHINA BARRED

TOKIO Aug. 20.—The South Manchuria Railway and all the cognate enterprises have been called Japanese colonies and your adversary is foolish enough to expose his back.

First on the part of one throw of the dice, when she had the chance in 1915 to seize China and secondly on resisting from the beginning the petty humiliations by shifting the capital to some distant place like Tsinanfu and fighting it out without delay."
