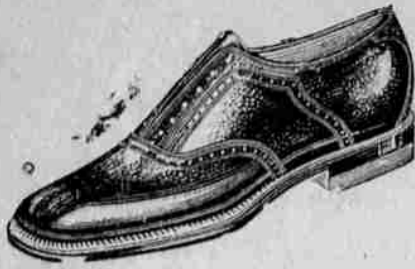

American Legion Convention Scheduled to be Held at That City September 6-8 Inclusive.

The attention of veterans of Oregon centers now on the rapidly approaching convention of The American Legion to be held at Seaside, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, September 6, 7, and 8. Excellence of the resort city as a convention place is attested by the ample hotel accommodations and numerous two-room cottages immediately available for the visitors in September. Reports from the convention committee, of which Pat Dillman is chairman, and Fred W. O'toole, secretary, indicate that reasonable rates have been promised legionnaires and their families, with the result that hundreds who may not be delegates to the meeting are expected to take advantage of the opportunity for an outing at the seashore with their families.

Special rates have been granted by the railroads and several automobile caravans are planned. Suitable parking privileges and splendid camping facilities await the motorist.

After the serious side of the convention has been taken care of the Seaside post intends to make certain that there is entertainment on hand for all. A "swine" roast on the beach, American Legion Ball at the Bungalow, marl, grass, airplane thrills, log rolling contests, athletic races and many other attractions will be provided.
