## GREEK REPLY UNACCEPTABLE TO ITALIANS

 lire indemnity and her request for a modification of the Italian demand regarding the saluting of the Italian flag is considered unsatisfactory.

Two hostile demonstrations by the Paselli were reported from the Greek consulate. A shield bearing the Greek arms was carried away.

Newspaper reports from Brindisi said that a Greek steamer scheduled to leave had been stopped.

The Italian steamer Adrian, which cleared for Levant, was ordered to go direct to Constantinople without touching a Greek port.

Newspapers have been warned against reporting military and naval movements.

 TANGHER, Morocco (AP) — The Italian destroyer Aurace has arrived here.

**Forces Landed.**  
 LONDON (AP) — A Central News dispatch from Rome reports that Italian forces have been landed at Tangier to protect the Italian colony.

**Greeks Reply**  
 ATHENS (By the Associated Press) — The Greek government has replied to the Italian ultimatum embodying demands for reparation for the massacre of the members of the Italian boundary mission at the Albanian frontier. Greece accepts four of Italy's demands with modifications, and rejects three of them.

The commandant of the place where the murders were committed, it is specified, shall express the Greek government's sorrow to Signor Mounagna, the Italian minister to Greece. A memorial service shall be held in the presence of members of the Greek government. On the same day a detachment of guard shall salute the Italian flag to the legation and military forces at reveille shall render honors to the bodies of the victims while they are being transferred to an Italian warship.

The fourth demand provides for the severest inquiry by the Greek authorities at the scene of the massacre, at which the Italian military attaché will be present. The fifth demands capital punishment for all the guilty, while the sixth demand seeks an indemnity of fifty million Italian lire

to be paid within five days from the presentation of the note.

The first demand covers apologies of the most sweeping and official nature; the second relates to the funeral ceremonies, the third to honors to the Italian flag by Greek warships, and the seventh to military honors to the victims.

LONDON (AP) — The Greek note in reply to the Italian ultimatum was handed to the Italian minister at 5 o'clock Thursday afternoon, says an Athens dispatch to the Exchange Telegraph. It is understood that Italy does not accept the Greek statement. Greece will appeal to the league of nations.

The note refutes the statement that the crime was committed under the eyes of the Greek authorities, and declares that the nearest Greek post was 10 kilometers distant from the scene of the killing. The note emphasizes that it has not been proved the assassins were Greeks, and expressed surprise at the Italian government's claim to possess documents relating to the massacre, and says that the Greek government has agreed to the request of the Italian legation that the censor will not suppress newspaper statements from Italian sources.
