Mr. Fisher gave a character analysis of several present. He will speak tonight at the Methodist church on "Our Ghosts—Fear, Worry and Nervousness" and he should be greeted by a large crowd, since his work is a sincere work and badly needed in our city.

WALLOWA CO. FAIR SUCCESS

WALLOWA, Ore. (Special)—The Wallowa county Fair held at Enterprise the past week proved very successful up until Saturday, when a rain began falling about 11 o'clock which continued until the track was so slick to allow any of the program to be put on in the afternoon. It was thought the weather of Sunday might permit the program to be finished, but rain continued to fall during the night and the entire day Sunday. The committee had taken special pains to work up a large program for the last day of the Fair. Ten riders were to ride in the semi-finals in the bucking contest, when the best four finishing were to ride for the finals, much disappointment was occasioned by the event being delayed.

HAY AND GRAIN IS UNTHRESHED

WALLOWA, Ore. (Special)—Much hay and unthreshed grain is still outside in the valley section of the country and the rain, unless it soon stops, will cause considerable damage. In the way of coloring the oats and barley, as they will not be first class stuff to go onto the market. Several factors have helped to hold the farmers back and make them late with their harvest. The shortage of help has been responsible for a large part of it, while the harvest season is nearly two weeks later than usual.

T. G. Johnson, living east of town has just finished threshing an 18-acre field of Jinkens Club wheat on some land he is farming on the hill north of Wallowa, the wheat made the unusual yield of 43 bushels per acre. The wheat is of an excellent quality. Many of the farmers of the dry farming section of the country, have commenced fall seeding, many have held off on seeding because of the dry condition of the soil, and the grasshoppers being bad in many places.

Blue Laws Denounced.
MILWAUKEE (AP)—Blue laws and reformers Tuesday, were denounced as a menace to the nation by the Seven Day Adventists leaders attending a world conference here. Nationally known champions of civil and religious liberty and separation of church and state, including the Rev. W. F.
