Rawlins in New Crook Play at The Star Wednesday Only

Herbert Rawlins, romantic hero of many mystery plays and crook dramas, in the star of "Hailcoast," the "Universal" photoplay, which comes to the Star Theatre Wednesday only.

The play is built around the life of the crook son of a noted English judge and is filled with dramatic situations. The son, whose real name is Richard Gordon, has assumed his identity under the name of Richard Hailcoast.

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Cognac Smuggled Into England Now

LONDON, (INS)—Britain has instituted a laboratory run-running business of its own.

Its location is the south coast of England, and the main commodity is French cognac. Before the war this used to cost about \$1 per bottle in England, but its present price is now twenty-five shillings, or a little over \$1. The increase is mainly due to revenue duty.

The country folk of England regard this as too much to pay and consequently they attempt to import it themselves without interference from revenue officials. There is no particular difficulty along this lonely coast, where the tall cliffs shelter numerous little coves, and the liquor arrives practically unmolested.

In such quantities is the brandy coming in all kinds of crafts that the local farm hand now refuses his native ale and finds it cheaper to drink the French spirit.

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VISITORS INCREASE L. A. DIVORCE RATE

LOS ANGELES, (INS)—Statistics just issued by the State Census Bureau bears out the recent Federal report that there are approximately five marriages to every divorce in the Rocky Mountain and Pacific Coast States.

The situation in this city, however, is not so good, local officials admit, because of the number of divorces filed here by couples wed elsewhere.

The Government figures showed that in 1916 there was one divorce to every 3.92 marriages. Last year—the calendar year for 1922—there were 1.98 marriages to each divorce.

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
