Thrilling Drama Made On Famed Southern Ranch; "The Love Brand" Showing at Star Soon.

"The Love Brand," Roy Stewart's latest stirring vehicle for Universal, which runs Tuesday and Wednesday to the Star Theatre, has its setting in a country of far horizons. Much of the play was filmed on the small mesas and wild sweep plains of Southwestern California, where the atmosphere still presents the romance of the days in the West before its glories were tarnished by "too many people."

It is essentially a play of exterior scenes and the vast acreage of the famous Santa Margarita rancho, one of the last remaining bits of the Spanish land grants in California, was utilized in the making of the production. The ranch contains approximately 250,000 acres, having within its boundaries mountains, plains, desert, rivers and lakes, and extending from the Pacific shores to the orange and lemon groves of the southwestern part of the state. Thousands of cattle and horses graze on the open plains, which offer virtually all of the freedom of the untamed range of earlier days.

The story was written especially for Stewart by Raymond L. Stranahan, general editor at Universal City, and scenario by Miriam Johnson Stuart Eaton directed.
