"Wonders of the Sea,"
Most Unusual Picture,
Now Showing at Star.

A most unusual picture is "Wonders of the Sea," the P. R. O. release which opened last night to a capacity audience at the Star Theatre. It is a picture peculiarly fascinating because of its revelation of life on the ocean bed—a picture certainly of tremendous appeal because of its entertainment and educational value. J. E. Williamson, the producer, is thoroughly familiar with his subject matter, being a pioneer with submarine photography. Here he takes us to the Bahamas and by means of a submarine chamber photographs the floor of the ocean, said to be forty feet below the surface.

As we look on in amazement at the marvelous array of pictures, which include the fish and plant life of the submerged gardens of the Bahamas, our striking feature reveals a girl swimming among the sea gardens and coral growths. Other views present an odd wreck which, according to a subtitle, is said to be near the original Treasure Island. "Wonders of the Sea" is fantastic and thrilling. When Mr. Williamson and another man go beneath the surface, diving tanks to explore the depths, the spectator is overwhelmed with suspense.

There is drama taking place down there when the producer squares the deadly moray, while the other diver has a narrow escape from an octopus. Seeing this, a diver's money, which is the end of the lance is enough to send shivers on and down the spine. Then the waters become suddenly dark and muddy—which is explained by the fact that the octopus has caught one of the men by the foot and the cloudy substance is camouflage thrown off to blind his victims. And the producer, who knows what he is talking about, states in a subtitle that wherever an octopus is, his enemy the shark, is not far away.

The producer wears the regulation diving suit, while his companion gets his oxygen from compressed air. The climax is a thriller. It shows a shark taking some bait and after a bit of flirtation with it, finally getting caught on the hook. When he is dragged to the surface, one gets a huge close-up of this demon of the deep, who has endeavored to choke up the bait. This scene disproves the theory that sharks turn over on their backs when they attack. The photography is wonderfully clear. In all a picture which is vastly entertaining.

A comedy and a tale Fox News is also being shown on this program that will be presented tonight for the last time.

ALASKA SALMON TOTALS
5,000,000 CASES FOR 1923

CORNOVA, Alaska, (AP)—The total salmon pack in Alaska this year will exceed 5,000,000 cases, it was estimated by E. M. Hall, assistant fisheries agent for Southeastern Alaska. Only two seasons produced an output larger than that of 1922, he said. A total of 5,922,358 cases were packed in 1917 and 6,677,569 in 1918. This year's large pack, Mr. Hall said, was due to increased production by canneries in Southeastern Alaska. In the Bristol Bay district, Southwestern Alaska, the pack this year was approximately 1,200,000 cases, compared to 1,474,221 last year, and in Central Alaska the pack for 1922 was 244,000, compared with 1922's total of 1,032,000.

Idaho Penitentiary Gives Medical Test

BOISE, Ida. (AP)—All prisoners in the Idaho state penitentiary will be subjected to a physical test by officials of the state bacteriological laboratory to determine whether they are free from social diseases, according to an announcement by Governor C. C. Moore. The new policy was outlined at a recent meeting of the state prison board. Hereafter, it was said, prisoners will be examined when they are committed to the institution and the diseased members will be segregated. Plans for rehabilitation of convicted persons also was discussed by members of the board at its most recent meeting. The next state legislature, it was asserted, will be asked for sufficient funds to make the construction of a new dormitory possible which would be used to separate the first offenders from the old-time convicts.

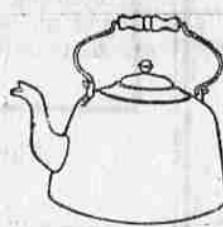

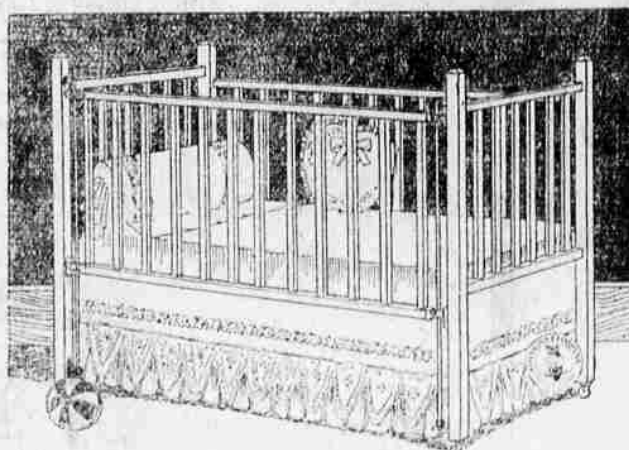

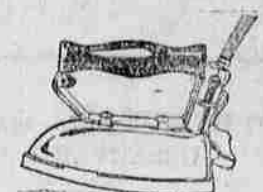
