## PLANS TO OPEN BUSINESS HERE

Phil Berg Announces Intentions of Establishing Himself in Real Estate Business.

## FALL GRAIN IS IN; COMING UP

Wallowa County Farmers Have Finished Sowing Winter Wheat; Many of Fields Now Green.

WALLOWA. (Special)—All farmers have finished the sowing of fall wheat. The first sowings are coming up in fine shape and giving the fields a greenish appearance. The rains of the month of October put the fields in excellent condition for the early germination of seed. While the later sowings are slow in showing up due to the freezing of the ground at night, it is felt that all seed will become sprouted before winter, giving reasonable assurance of a good stand next year. The average of wheat sown this fall appears to be very large in this section of the country. Practically all dry land farmers follow the system of sowing following half of the tillable land each year, giving him an equal chance for a good crop each season. Many excellent yields were reported from land sown to spring crop last spring. However, few farmers really favor the sowing of spring crops on dry land, too many failures during the past have caused them to adhere to the more sure thing. Following the policy of sowing winter wheat, where the crop can be planted early enough in the fall to insure it getting started off well before winter, and maturing while there is an abundance of moisture the next season.

## RAINIER APPLE HELD A WONDER

The famous "Rainier Apple," winner of the "Wildcat Medal" given by the American Pomological Society at Council Bluffs, Iowa, last year, said to be the world's highest fruit award, is on display at the La Grande Investment company this week, according to C. W. Everett, representing the Washington Nursery company of Tappan, Wash., who is here for a sale.

Mr. Everett believes that the Rainier apple was made for Eastern Oregon and that Eastern Oregon can make for the Rainier apple, which means that he thinks the Rainier apple can be raised far more successfully here than anywhere. With that end in view he is striving to introduce the fruit.

His description of the apple follows: "High yellowish green underneath with an over coloring of dark red slightly streaked, flesh yellowish with practically no grain, mild flavored, slightly subacid, with a pleasant aroma, extra long keeping, keeping in common storage until April, and cold storage until October, good to eat from January on; brings the top price on the market."

## DOGS SAVED WOMAN'S LIFE

THE DARTS, Ore. (AP)—Mrs. Ruby Pettis, 53, who lives on a ranch at Shesler Bridge, near here, told in a hospital here Tuesday how her life had been saved by her two dogs, Jack and Pop. While driving a loaded wagon Sunday, the wagon stuck in a hollow, pinning her beneath the load. Suddenly the dogs in digging a hole under her head and upper part of her body enabled her to breathe but she was unable to extricate herself, being forced to remain a prisoner for 15 hours until Monday when a ranch hand heard the barking of the dogs and rescued her. Mrs. Pettis is recovering from exhaustion and bruise.
