### PACIFIC FRUIT EXPRESS ORDERS MANY NEW CARS

Orders for the building of 2057 new refrigerator cars for delivery prior to the peak of the 1924 season are being placed by the Pacific Fruit Express Company, it was announced today by C. M. Scherel, Vice-President and General Manager of the Company. It is estimated the cost of the cars will be about \$10,000,000.

On November 1 there remained to be delivered on orders for this year a total of 675 refrigerator cars, added to the purchase just authorized, will make available next season 2732 more cars than were in service this season, or an increase of about 14 per cent.

The cars now being ordered will increase the total equipment owned by the Pacific Fruit Express Company to more than 30,500 refrigerator cars. In addition to the orders mentioned on November 1 there remained to be delivered 215 refrigerator cars designed for passenger train service on previous orders for 300 such cars. All of these should be delivered within the next two or three months and be available for early spring traffic.

These cars are used exclusively for moving to market fruit and vegetable business originating in those sections of California, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Utah, Colorado, Arizona, Texas and Louisiana served by the Pacific Fruit Express.

In commenting on the new refrigerator car construction, officials of the Southern Pacific and the Union Pacific, joint owners of the Pacific Fruit Express, pointed out that the large increase in equipment should greatly facilitate movement of next season's crops.

The new purchase of cars for next year was authorized after officials and experts of the company had made a close survey of conditions in producing centers.

Records show that the Pacific Fruit Express Company's refrigerator car equipment, with the 2057 new cars will have been increased in excess of 15,000 cars since the period of government control, or about 100 per cent.

In addition to this vast expenditure for refrigerator cars, the company is enlarging its icing station at Roseville and also increasing facilities for handling cars at other distributing points.

Mr. Scherel explained that these great expenditures were made necessary by the very rapid growth of the fruit and vegetable business in the western territory served by the company.

### Paris in Third Place: Surpassed At Small Population Increase

PARIS, (AP)—Paris, with a population of 2,866,000 now holds third place among the largest cities in the world, ranking after New York and London according to official statistics of the French Ministry of Commerce.

Great surprise has been expressed in view of the congested condition of the French capital and the absolute impossibility of finding apartments, that the population of Paris has only increased a few thousands during the last 10 years. In 1910 the population of Paris numbered 2,858,000.

Canada Second in Auto Exports. OTTAWA, Ont. (AP)—Canada has become second among the nations of the world in exporting automobiles. Exports of cars by the Dominion, official figures show, amounted to \$1,241 in the twelve months ended September 1. This was within 40 per cent of the total cars exported by the United States. During the same period, which numbered 131,048.
