

BRITISH FLEET DIVISION WILL CIRCLE GLOBE

LONDON.—Two battle cruisers and five light cruisers, comprising the first fleet division, are scheduled to start within the next few days on "Shooting the Flag" cruise, which every will encircle the globe.
