

## BUSINESS HELD GOOD IN WEST

SAN FRANCISCO, (AP)—Active autumn trade, productive activity in industries and a few (but considerable) amount of unemployment are reported in the statement issued by the federal reserve board of the Pacific district, comprising the states of Arizona, California, Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Utah and Washington.

"The record for October shows a greater than seasonal increase in the volume of business transacted," says the report, "as indicated by definite individual accounts and carries a suggestion of continued activity in its figures on building permits issued. Eliminating seasonal variations, debit to individual accounts at banks in 21 reporting clearing houses centers, was 13.2 per cent greater during October, 1923, than during October, 1922, and 2.9 per cent greater than during September, 1923.

"Prospective building operations have shown record proportions during October, when the number of building permits issued in 29 large cities located in all sections of the district was 13.3 per cent greater than in the previous record month of March, 1922."
