Tunney Wins Title From Harry Greb

NEW YORK (AP)—Gene Tunney of Greenwich Village, successfully defended his American light heavyweight title Monday night in a thrilling 15-round match with Harry Greb of Pittsburgh at Madison Square Garden. Tunney's body attack earned him the judges' verdict despite a whirlwind rally by Greb in the last round.

challenger often landed with long punches in the jaw and body, these actions stopped the champion's steady body work. Tunney and Greb in distress in several of the closing rounds but in the fifteenth Greb unleashed a furious attack that threatened for a moment to topple the champion.

Setting a terrific pace in the closing round, Greb pummeled Tunney on the head and body, forcing the champion to his heels with several punches. But it was Greb's last desperate stand, a stiff counterpunch, that failed to counter-balance the wide margin Tunney had piled up on points.

A majority of critics gave nine rounds to Tunney, four to Greb and called two even.

It was the third clash between the pair for the American title. Greb won it from Tunney last year but lost it to the Greenock Village man last year. Greb lost prior bouts also going to the 10.

Tunney scored 175-pounds Monday night while Greb weighed 171.
