**Miss Byrd, Oregon's Own Daughter, to Appear at Arcade Thursday Evening**

Very seldom the people in a town the size of La Grande are given an opportunity to hear such a nationally known artist as Winifred Byrd who is to appear at the Arcade Theatre Thursday evening of this week. With the exception of going up for "theater" entertainment, the managers sometimes wonder if the people are so stupid as they are to have officers believe from the support that is given ready "worth-while" things.

Of Miss Byrd's recent concert in New York, Mr. James Gibbons Hunter, writer on the New York Times has the following to say: "We always enjoy the piano playing of Winifred Byrd. She made her last bow of the season at a recital in Aeolian Hall yesterday which furnished forth several reasons for her popularity. She is musical—sure one. She possesses a finished technique—sure two. She is instinctively and self-consciously a pianist. Her present instrument in her playing is her chief charm. Alone it would elude a multitude of technical defects if there were many to elude. With it she might even play without brains; there are so many hemmed-in pliancies of several notes who scribble over the piano as a whole without a head. In this case, the received legal thought makes the scribble. But Miss Byrd has plenty of intellect. Her readings are logical, her phrasing crabworthy because of its formal balance, her command of color or discreet, tasteful, admirable, and her various touches penetratingly musical—that word will bias you again. With all her precision her style is large. And then she has lived and worked in the tremendous neighborhood of Teresa Carreno, that Valkyrie of the keyboard, a genuine pupil of the great Venezuelan artist."

Seats for this concert are now on sale at Glass Drug Store with the exception of the balcony seats which are not reserved and will go on sale at the ticket window Thursday evening.

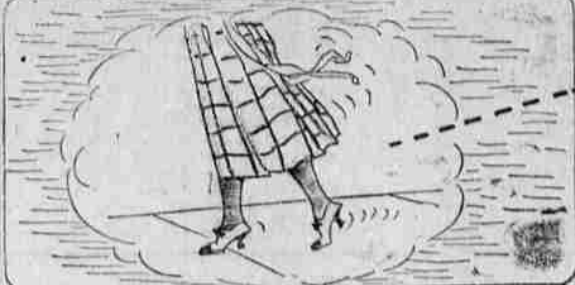
**Comedy Drama at Sherry Today Contains a Big Heart Appeal**

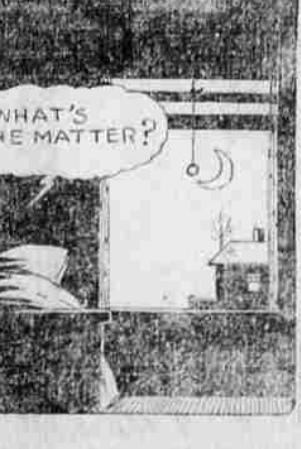
