**Coach Would Amend
Football Codes for
U. S.-Canadian Games**

DARTON, (AP)—International interscholastic football contests between American and Canadian colleges would be made entirely practicable by certain minor changes in both codes of rules, in the opinion of Frank Shaugnessy, coach of McGill University, Montreal.

Speaking from his experience in football on both sides of the border, he said the chief obstacle to a common code for the sport was the difference in the rules regarding interference. In the Canadian game the offensive team must gain ten yards in three downs while in the United States a team is given four downs to gain the same distance.

In Canada interference also is restricted to three yards in front of the line when the ball is put into play and allowed to interfere. Here interference is unlimited.

The McGill coach said he believed that modification of the Canadian rules regarding interference to conform to American standards would benefit the game there. He also took the stand that introduction of the forward pass into the Canadian game would be beneficial and that adoption of the Canadian rules regarding kicking behind an opponent's goal line would help the American game.

In Canada kicking behind the opposing team's goal counts for a single point if the opponent is unable to carry or kick out on the playing field.

American players as a rule, according to Shaugnessy, are superior to Canadian in line play and line plunging, but Canadian excel in open field running and kicking.

The appearance of the McGill football team against Dartmouth at Hanover next fall will mark its first appearance in New England in many years, although McGill is credited with having introduced the highly game in the United States in a contest with Harvard in 1874.

creation the length of the road, the character of the ground, the nature of the travel, the cost of construction and the money available to pay for the same. The defendants further alleged in their answer that a crushed rock macadam road, constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared therefor, would constitute a permanent public road within the meaning of the law.

Writ Dismissed.
On April 6th, 1922, a writ was had in the Circuit Court and on April 26th the court ordered and adjudge that the alternative writ be dismissed. From this judgment of the Circuit Court an appeal was taken by the petitioners to the Supreme Court.

This case was heard by the court sitting in banc, and in an opinion written by Mr. Justice Brown and filed on the 18th day of December, 1922, the judgment of the Circuit Court was affirmed.

"Permanent" Defined.
The Supreme Court first takes up the question whether or not a crushed rock macadam road is a "permanent road" within the meaning of the law. After quoting at length from a number of standard authorities, Mr. Justice Brown says:

"Permanent," as used in the statute, is not equivalent to "perpetual." If the County court were compelled to build a road between the points named that would last forever, the amount of funds on hand would be clearly insufficient. He then alludes to the ancient roads constructed by the Egyptians, Babylonians and Romans.

and continuing says: "However, it is necessary to make backward through several centuries to determine that the word 'permanent' as used in our road laws, has a definite term. The term 'permanent' roads has a well defined meaning in the jurisprudence of Oregon. In this state the practical construction placed upon the term 'permanent roads' includes macadam highways."

In taking up the next phase of the case Mr. Justice Brown says: "Proposition statements seem to be largely responsible for this litigation. However, the outgoing members of the county court could not, by unofficial utterances, bind the hands of the present officials constituting the county court. The county court is a court of record and speaks through its journal. The present county court of Union county could not escape, if it would, the responsibility of selecting the type of road to be constructed from Island City to The Cove. It is a duty the law places upon the court. The selectors provide the funds, but the court plans and constructs the road."

"It will be seen that the election was not held for the purpose of determining the kind of character of permanent road to be constructed, but that the people voted upon the question as to whether or not they should empower the county court to issue bonds and warrants for the purpose of building and maintaining a permanent highway."

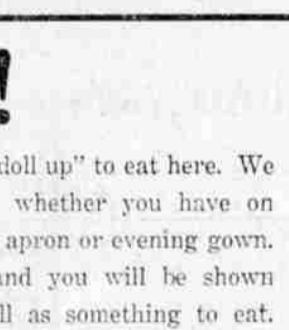
