That's what started the excitement. Bell-Hankins (played by Maurice Flynn) spies his old pal Tod and makes a bee-line for him. Both of the young men are broke. Tod accepts his empty pockets philosophically. Bell, however, orders a sumptuous meal, invites a cow lady in cabaret dancer's attire to join them, and then, not content with the mischief bound to result, commences to flirt with a flashing-eyed dancer sitting with an impassioned swain from Mexico. The Mexicans, observing the display of winks, gets nasty and his hand-cases toward a wicked knife in his belt. Tod's quick eye takes this in and he acts—none too quickly, either. Sweeping the food from the boards, he swings the table up as a shield, and the Mexican's knife, intended for Bell, stings harmlessly against it.

Then a free-for-all slips into play, necessitating Tod's and Bell's quick get-away. From this point on, the action increases until, over the end of this feature, it is climaxed by a gigantic avalanche, the like of which has never before been seen on the silver sheet. This avalanche plunges amid clouds of dense dust down a hillside, wrecking havoc in its path and, but for the arrival of the sheriff and his men, burying the three principals of this story in the cabin completely covered by dirt and rocks.
