# SPORT NEWS

## NAVY GETS EVEN SCORE 14 TO 14

University of Washington Battles Eastern Eleven to Tie at Pasadena.

PARADENA. (By the Associated Press)—The Washington-Navy football game resulted in a 14 to 14 tie.

ROBE ROWE, Pasadena, Cal.—The United States Naval academy football team and the University of Washington's non-college grid-iron machine fought an even game here in the annual New Year's east versus west contest. The final score was 14 to 14. The game, the most brilliant of the long series of intersectional clashes from the spectator's viewpoint, was witnessed by a crowd estimated at 15,000.

Coach Bob Folsom's cadets played a wide open style of football from the first kickoff, and had not far, in the form of a mid pass by Center Matthews in the first period intervened, it is probable that the east would have triumphed. The Navy proved superior in every department, with the exception of punting, where honors were even.

Huskies Tighten Defense  
The ability of the Huskies to tighten their defense at critical moments saved them from possible defeat. After the navy had carried the ball to the three-inch line in the first period the Huskies stopped three plunges at the line of scrimmage and took the ball.

The 16 passes completed by the cadets, 11 of them in the first half, testify to the brilliance of their aerial attack. Only two of their passes were intercepted. The midshipman accounted for their second touchdown with a variety of forward passes never before seen on a western gridiron.

## FRED FULTON IS WINNER OVER G. LAMSON TUESDAY

PORTLAND (AP)—Fred Fulton knocked out George Lamson in the second round of a main event fought here on New Year's Day.

PORTLAND Ore. — Fred Fulton, heavyweight boxer of Minn-

neapolis, knocked out George Lamson of Omaha in the second round of their scheduled 10-round bout here Tuesday. Lamson was sent to the floor twice in the second round before he stayed down for the full count. In a 16-round bout Danny Nunes, Sacramento featherweight, successfully defended his Pacific coast championship belt against Weldon Wing, Portland. Nunes won a decision.

## Villa Beats Norman.

PITTSBURGH, Pa. (AP)—Pancho Villa, flyweight champion of the world, won the judges' decision over Tony Norman of Pittsburgh in a 15-round bout here Tuesday afternoon. Villa outfought Norman in every round except the 10th which was about even. In the sixth round Villa clipped Norman on the head with a right and Norman went down for the count of eight. He was groggy when he got up but the bell saved him. Villa scattered 114 and Norman 112.
