Bret Harte Classic "Salomy Jane" Opens at Arcade Today.

Breathing the same spirit which prompted Bret Harte to write his famous stories of the west, the Paramount production, "Salomy Jane," which is the attraction at the Arcade Theatre today and Wednesday with the wild romance of the picturesque days of '49. It is a superb picture and an epic of early civilization in California.

In this story history is brought to life. The lawless pioneers of the west who roamed through Boulder Creek canyon in Northern California in the late forties live again on the screen. It is a story of the primitive love of the westerner, mingled with his craving for vengeance and his crude sense of justice. The picture was made on the spot where Bret Harte gained inspiration for his story by the same name. It was adapted by Waldemar Young.

The tale opens with a stagecoach robbery and Red Pete, the laziest man in the settlement, is one of the two robbers. Red Pete's little daughter, accidentally finds a bracelet taken by her father from one of the passengers in the stage. She gives it to Salomy Jane, daughter of Madison Clay. To clear her father, Salomy is forced to tell the truth and Red Pete is seized by the Vigilantes, an organization of settlers formed to keep the peace.

A stranger in the village that day is charged with having been Red Pete's partner in crime, and the two are about to be led away to be hanged. Salomy Jane, in a whimsical mood, kisses the stranger goodbye. Red Pete is hanged and the stranger escapes. Meanwhile Madison Clay is carrying on a bloody feud with Larabee, a rough pioneer. Larabee mistakes the escaping stranger for Clay, and in the ensuing fight Larabee is killed. Dying, he confesses that Baldwin, now dead, was the other man in the hold-up. Thus Salomy and her stranger sweetheart find happiness.

Included in the cast are Jacqueline Logan, George Fawcett, and Maurice Flynn, the feathered players. Miss Logan plays the naive part, while Maurice Flynn takes the role of the stranger. Mr. Fawcett is seen as Yuba Bill, the stagecoach driver. The picture is quite worth while.

Income Tax Tips

No. 4. While the exemptions for married persons are \$2,500 if their net income was \$5,000 or less, and \$2,000 if the net income was in excess of \$5,000, there is inserted in the revenue act a qualifying clause in justice to those persons whose net income just exceeded \$5,000. The act provides that the reduction of the amount of the exemption shall not increase by more than the amount of net income in excess of \$5,000 the tax which would be payable had the exemption been \$2,500. For example, Mr. and Mrs. John Doe had a net income for 1923 of \$5,010. With
