Congress Discusses Farmer Relief Plans

(Continued from page 1)

On the Norris-Stuckey bill proposing a \$100,000,000 corporation to buy and sell American farm products both at home and abroad. Wallace Discusses Grazing. Co-ordination of grazing on all state and national public lands was proposed by Secretary Wallace at a conference with western state senators and representatives as a step to improve conditions in stock raising. He suggested legislation to permit, under certain conditions, addition to the national forests of contiguous unreserved public lands chiefly valuable for grazing livestock. The secretary said there should be no increase in grazing fees until the industry was reorganized.

The perpetuation and conservative use of the vast forage resources on the public domain has been almost disregarded and no small part of the insecurity and hazardous nature of the livestock industry in the west at the present time is due to inaction on this question. Secretary Wallace informed the members of congress.

There are some 175,000,000 acres of open and unreserved public range lands in the west which have been used without regulation by the livestock industry, he said, resulting in striking deterioration in the productivity of these areas. In addition there are approximately 110,000,000 acres of grazing land within the national forests and over 25,000,000 acres of private and state lands and other federal reservations which are capable of being grazed. Regulation of the unreserved public domain would make possible a better control of the spring, fall and winter ranges and would remove one of the greatest handicaps to stability in the livestock industry, agricultural department officials said.

Senator Stanfield Is Sued by Banker

PORTLAND.—Suit has been filed by W. L. Thompson, vice president of the First National bank against United States Senator Robert N. Stanfield, to collect on a promissory note for \$16,050, said to have been signed by Stanfield on November 8, 1923.

According to the complaint Stanfield "has failed and neglected to pay said note or any portion thereof, although often requested to do so." The note was to bear 7 per cent interest. Attorney fees of \$1500 are asked, beside the full amount of the note and interest. Instantly, Wilson & Huntington are representing the plaintiff. Coincident with Thompson suit, a similar suit was started against Stanfield by W. J. Furnish, real estate investor, for a like amount, on another promissory note. The two suits were identical in language.

Candidate for Sheriff.
EUGENE, Oreg.—The first candidate for Lane county office to appear this year is Frank E. Taylor Thurston, dairyman, who has announced himself for the republican nomination for sheriff at the May primaries. Mr. Taylor has lived in Lane county the greater part of his life.
