State Help: Australians Own Their Own Homes.

Melbourne, (AP)—Accepting the ownership of a home as evidence of individual prosperity, Australians can claim to rank among the most prosperous people in the world. Probably in no other country does such a large proportion of the population own their homes. Mainly as the result of activities of the state governments in providing facilities for persons of limited means to acquire their own homes, the number of private dwellings occupied by owners, and dwellings purchased by installment, total 447,925 and 127,932 respectively. The commonwealth statistician has recorded that the percentage proportion of owners and prospective owners to the total vary among the states in the following order: Queensland, 54.41 per cent; Western Australia, 53.65; South Australia, 53.32; Victoria, 52.54; Tasmania, 52.76; and New South Wales, 50.25. Therefore, more than half the people of Australia live in self-owned homes.

Australia to Sink Dreadnaught—MELBOURNE, (AP)—The dreadnaught "Australia," which is to be destroyed under the Washington treaty, will probably be sunk outside Sydney Harbor when the British Cruiser Squadron visits Australia.

It is expected that the squadron will reach western Australia late in February, and will visit other Australian ports between then and the end of April.

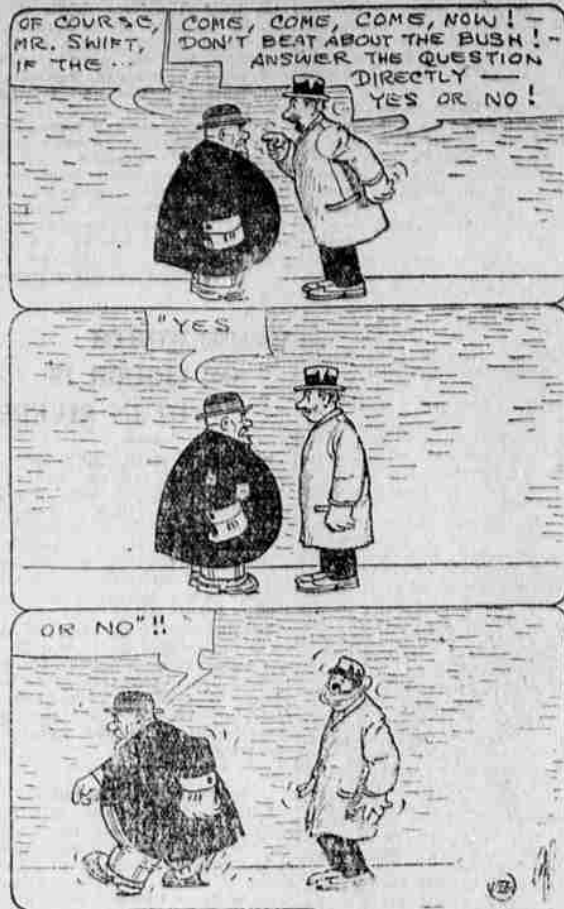

INCOME TAX MEN TO VISIT CITY; WILL GIVE AID

PORTLAND, Ore.—Oregon taxpayers again this year will have the assistance of experienced disputer from the office of Clyde G. Huntley, collector of internal revenue. In preparing their federal income tax return for the year 1923, beginning January 29 and continuing until and including March 15, which is the final day for filing returns, these disputer will visit all of the principal cities and towns in the state and personally assist perplexed taxpayers to make out their statements of income and compute the tax due the government.

La Grande will be visited February 25—March 27. Enterprise, February 19 to 25; Baker March 6 to 15 and Pendleton February 29 to March 15.

Rockefeller Aid for Edinburgh. FEDERAL BANK FIGURES OUT

SPOKANE, Wash., (AP)—A substantial business was carried on by the Federal Land bank of Spokane for the year 1923, according to figures announced by D. G. O'Shea, president, and indications are that there will be no decrease this year. During the twelve-month period 4331 farm mortgage loans for a total of \$15,406,000 were completed, he said. In December, 1923, 211 loans were made for \$241,000.

Since the bank opened for business in May, 1917, it has received 60,284 applications for loans amounting to \$211,311,000. Nearly 50 per cent of the applications failed of approval and more than 50 per cent of the money asked was rejected.

Completed business for the six and one-half years amounts to 29,256 loans for \$24,000,000, the report said.

At the present time there are 502 national farm-loan associations in the district of the Spokane bank, which includes Washington, Oregon, Idaho and Montana. More than one-third of the total loans are credited to Washington. Capital stock of the bank increased from \$750,000, advanced by the treasury department in 1917, to \$4,457,576 and the entire
