U. OF O. TRACK SQUAD IS OUT

Nightly Workouts Preparatory for Spring Season in Order at the University.

EUGENE, Or. (AP)—Although outdoor workouts for the University of Oregon track squad will not be held until fair weather, nearly all athletes who will compete in the spring are now working out nightly. Bill Hayward, veteran coach and trainer, is taking the men in hand, and while he is not predicting a championship team, he says he is not dependent upon the probable outcome.

Several meets are scheduled for next spring, as well as conference meets in which all schools of the Northwest will take part. Candidates for practically every track and field event are turning out but Coach Hayward has reserved any comment on them until he has gained a better line on their capabilities. Several veterans remain this year around whom Hayward expects to build his varied team. Leading the list is Ralph Spessard, holder of the intercollegiate pole vault record, and a handsome man in both the high and broad jump. Spessard will probably try for a place on the American Olympic team, Hayward said, the trials for which are scheduled to be held in Boston next June.

Two candidates, Jack Lewis and Merle Snyder, are turning out for the sprints, and L. M. Anderson has started work on the javelin throw. W. A. Rosebraugh and V. R. Rieley, veteran quarter-milers have also put in an appearance.

BETTER CREW WORK IS AIM

University of California to Stress Water Sport in the Future.

BERKELEY, Cal. (AP)—Radical changes in organization and management of the University of California crew squad, designed to place the Blue and Gold shell men in the forefront of college crews, are planned. Employment of a full-time coach, larger quarters and a campaign to arouse interest in the water sport will be the first steps taken.

While there is no dissatisfaction with the work of Coach Ben Wallis, it was said, Wallis can only devote part of his time to crew coaching, and a full-time coach is desired by crew fans.

Wallis's successor is believed to have already been picked, and formal announcement of the selection will soon be made. The new California coach is a University of Washington (Seattle) product and is from the school of Coach Herbert Conibear, which turned out Coach Leander, who is now successfully training Yale oarsmen.

PILOTS PREPARE FOR SPEED BOAT RACES IN MARCH

MIAMI, Fla. (AP)—Entries already have begun to come in for the speed boat regatta to be held at Miami and Miami Beach, March 7 and 8, and at Havana March 12 and 13, 1924. C. P. Chapman, secretary of the American Power Boat Association, in announcing the list of entrants reveals the fact that Gar Wood of Detroit will not compete this season. His physician has ordered him not to race.

The sweepstakes (thirty class) sail for open displacement boats of over 25 feet in length, equipped with motors of not more than 1-350 cubic inches, and displacement vessels of more than 32 feet in length, with not more than 1,650 cubic inches displacement. A qualifying speed of 40 miles an hour is required. TEACH REALTY CAREERS NOW

Many Colleges Have Added Real Estate Business to Their Curricula.

CHICAGO, (AP)—The growing importance of real estate as a vocation is evidenced in the establishment of real estate courses and curricula in leading universities and colleges, many of them pointed toward degrees, declares the National Association of Real Estate Boards here, which has just completed a survey.

"Columbia university, which already is offering many of the courses in the suggested real estate curriculum, expects to put on the two-year course," officials said. "The University of Wisconsin, the University of Chicago and the University of Illinois have become actively interested in real estate education, and The University of Michigan is planning to put on the course as soon as possible."

"Northwestern University through Dean Ralph E. Helman, representative of the American College Association on the joint committee of educators, economic research specialists and realtors, who are working out the whole outline of real estate education nationally, is at present working on a plan to include a full four-year course in real estate, leading to the regular academic degree. Iowa State College has taken up the selection of instructors."

"The Atlanta School of Technology has adopted the full four-year college course. Boston University offers real estate courses under the direction of the Boston Real Estate Exchange; The University of Southern California and the University of California have actively undertaken this branch of vocational preparation, and the University of Missouri and the University of Oregon are accumulating material looking to the development of a four-year course. The University of Arkansas and The College of William and Mary are planning the introduction of a real estate course." Oregon University.
