FREEDOM OF AIR UPHELD

Aviators' Rights Are Sustained by a District Judge in Minnesota Court.

ST. PAUL, (AP)—The old common-law maxim, "whom the soil begets" is from the heavens to the depths of the earth," was overruled in a decision by Judge John C. Mitchell of the District Court of Minnesota.

"Condemnation of air laws is not possible because aircraft can not adhere strictly to a defined course," Judge Mitchell's decision said.

Judge Mitchell said that while there was some danger to persons and property from aircraft, accidents were infrequent and "this hazard is infinitely less than that encountered in every walk of life from various other causes."

While granting the plaintiff damages the judge, in refusing the injunction said that "modern progress and great public interest should not be blocked by unnecessary legal refinements."

SODIUM FLUORIDE REMEDY CONTROLS POULTRY "LICE"

The use of sodium fluoride is well beyond the experimental stage. Various experiment stations, the federal department of agriculture, and thousands of poultrymen have found by actual experience that this is a most satisfactory treatment for poultry lice.

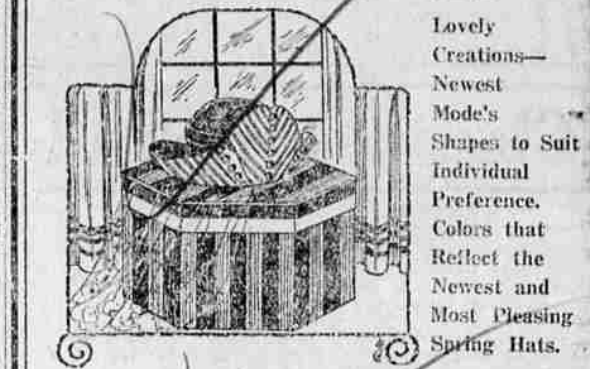
