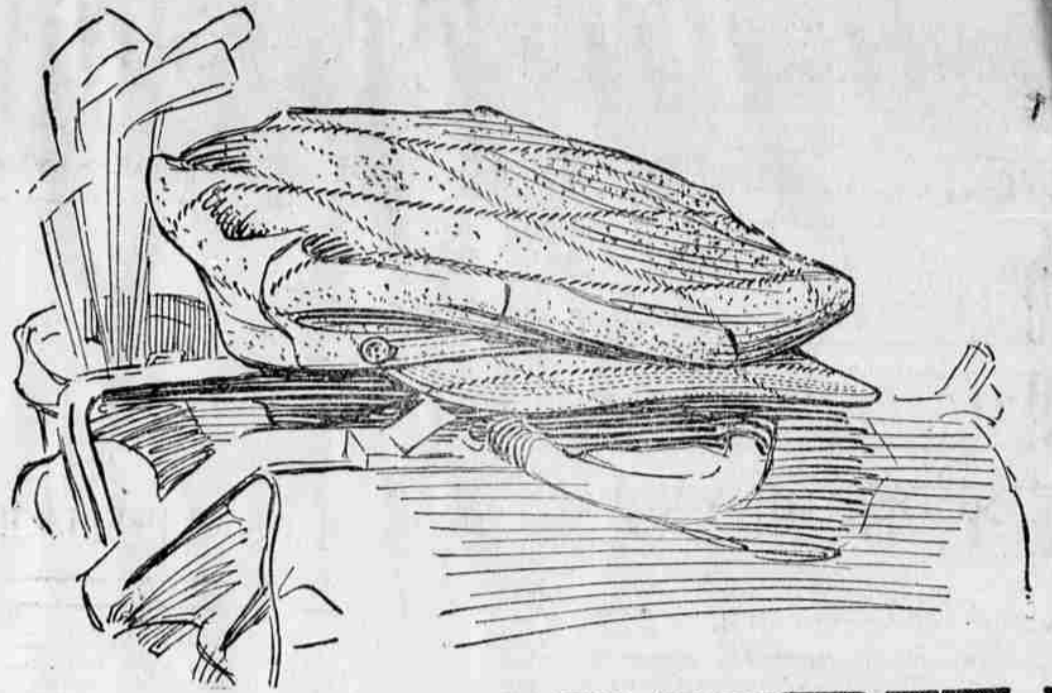

GOVERNMENT TO PROBE INTO THE GASOLINE PRICE

WASHINGTON (AP)—The department of justice will immediately set in motion its machinery to go to the bottom of charges by Governor McMaster of South Dakota, that "alleged interests of the Standard Oil" had cornered the crude oil supply and enhanced gasoline prices. The department action has been taken upon instruction from President Coolidge to was directed Thursday in a telegram from the South Dakota governor setting forth his charge and also a similar message from Governor Bryan of Nebraska. Shortly after the announcement that the president had ordered an inquiry into the gasoline and crude oil situation, former Representative Campbell of Kansas, speaking for the Prairie Oil and Gas company, submitted to the executive a statement giving

reasons for fluctuation of crude oil and gasoline prices in the last year.

England Reports Lowest Death Rate on Record

LONDON (AP)—Sir Walter Runcie, controller of the National Health Insurance department, is rather optimistic about the health of the people of Great Britain. In a recent speech Sir Walter said that despite the fact that during the last few years they had been passing through the greatest wave of depression the country had known since the Napoleonic era, the health of the people was steadily improving. Last year, he added, the death rate was the lowest on record and the infant mortality rate was about one-half of that of 15 to 20 years ago. It was a cheering fact to remember, the speaker concluded, that a child born today had an expectation of life 12 years longer than had his grandfather.

STOCKHOLM (AP)—A new building material made from waste paper and designed for

ceilings and wall linings has been perfected by a Swedish engineer, and production on a large scale soon will be undertaken. The raw materials are ordinary

waste paper such as accumulated in cities, clay and sulphate lye, the cheapness of which warrants an inexpensive furnished product. The covering is said to be fire-proof and durable; can be applied by unskilled labor, will take paper, paint or stain, and can even be polished. It is a good non-conductor, and does not respond to changes in temperature.
