Lon Chaney Took 1,350 Hours to Don Makeup in "Hunchback"

Thirteen hundred and fifty hours devoted to donning his make-up before the first performance, is the record of Lon Chaney, star of "The Hunchback of Notre Dame," which opens its limited engagement at the Arcade Theatre on Thursday. The production was twelve solid months in the making and each day it took Chaney four and one-half hours to submerge his personality in that of "Quasimodo," the hunchback bell-ringer of Notre Dame. It was one of the most complicated pieces of make-up ever attempted.

The fact that Victor Hugo was an artist, in fact not generally known, and that he had illustrated his own famous book, was of incalculable assistance to both the star and the other players, in visualizing the characters.

Universal spared no expense in the producing of the masterpiece. The entire Cathedral of Notre Dame was rebuilt at Universal City in eight squares of Parisian houses and castles of the period of Louis XI. Seventy-five noted artists, including such famous players as Ernest Torrence, Patric Bush Miller, Brandon Hurst, Tully Marshall, Norman Kerry and Gladys Brockwell, support the star.
